Definitions

Other Regular Faculty: Individuals who teach on a recurring contractual basis and are not eligible for academic tenure (instructors, lecturers, visiting faculty).

Faculty FTE: Total regular instructional faculty FTE for filled faculty positions from the Fall 2002 personnel file, excluding any portion of FTE supported by external or separately budgeted funds for purposes other than teaching (i.e., research or service).

SCH: Student credit hours per FTE instructional faculty.

OC Sections (Ex. Lab): Undergraduate organized class sections per FTE instructional faculty. These are courses provided principally by means of regular scheduled classes for a unique group of students meeting in classrooms or similar facilities at stated times. These do not include labs, discussions, or recitations. Cross-listed courses are only counted once. Co-taught courses are apportioned according to the number of instructors of record.

OC Sections (Inc. Lab): Organized class sections per FTE instructional faculty, *including* labs, discussions, and recitations.

FTE Students Taught: Student credit hours generated by the courses offered divided by a full-time course load (15 credit hours for undergraduates and 9 credit hours for graduates) per FTE instructional faculty.

Pct Bachelor's: The average number of bachelor's degrees awarded in the program over the period from 1999-2000 through 2001-2002 divided by the average number of total degrees (Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctorate) awarded in the same period.
