Waivable Fees

Undergraduate student bills include three fees that may be waived. The Mass PIRG and Child Care fees are optional and can be waived online through a student's SPIRE account. The Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) is mandatory for students who are not already covered by health insurance. For students who are covered under a qualified health insurance policy, this fee will be waived provided they complete the Student Health Insurance waiver process online through SPIRE.
