*** All requirements must be met in order to receive a tuition credit. This includes, but it not limited to the following:**

- Permanent legal resident of Massachusetts for at least one year prior to the opening of the academic year
- U.S. citizen and non-citizen eligible under Title IV Regulations
- Compliance with Selective Service Registration
- Not in default on any federal or state student loans for attendance at any institution or owe a refund for an previous financial aid received
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress in accordance with institutional and federal standards

PLEASE NOTE: tuition credits cannot be *stacked*, meaning a student can apply only one tuition credit per semester.

**** This applies to full-time employees only. Part-time employees are eligible for 25% credit.**
