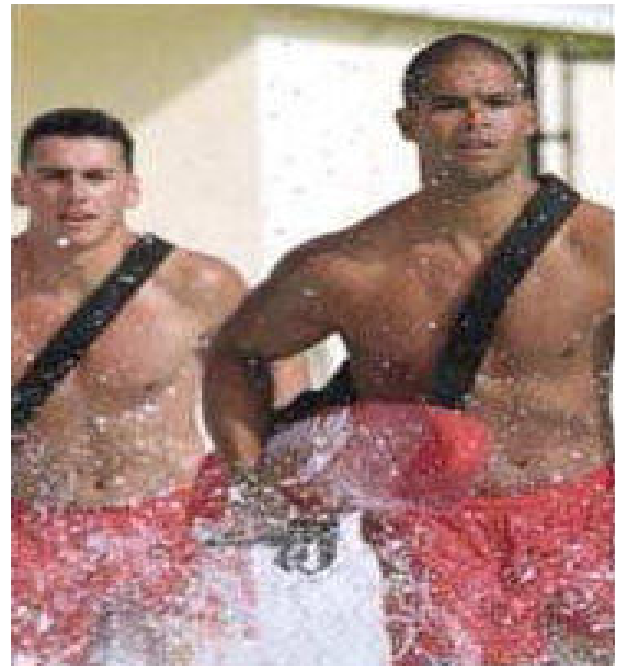

Learn how to save lives by becoming an American Red Cross trained lifeguard!

- Earn money and respect
- Have fun
- Meet great people
- Develop leadership skills
- Gain valuable work experience

To enroll, you must pass an untimed, 300-yard swim test using front crawl and breast stroke. In a maximum of 1 minute, 40 seconds, you must swim 20 yards to retrieve a 10-pound brick from a depth of 10 feet, swim back to the starting point while holding the brick in both hands, keeping face out of water, place the brick on the pool edge & exit without using a ladder or steps.



COST: \$225 (CASH ONLY)
Includes Lifeguard Certification, Standard First Aid, CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer

SWIM TEST: Saturday, 4/4 4:00pm Boyden Pool

CLASS DATES: Sunday, 4/5, Saturday, 4/11, Sunday, 4/19, Sunday, 4/26

TIME: 12:00-7:00pm
Attendance is mandatory for ALL dates and times

LOCATION: Boyden Pool & classrooms

ELIGIBILITY: Open to UMass & non-UMass students
Must be at least age 15 by April 1, 2009

REGISTRATION: Campus Recreation, 215 Boyden, UMass Amherst
Must register in advance

Re-certification Only

\$150 (CASH ONLY)
Must have current lifeguard certification or within 30 days of expiration

SWIM TEST: Saturday, 4/4 4:00pm Boyden Pool

CLASS DATES/TIMES: 4:00-7:00pm Saturday, 4/11, Sunday, 4/19
12:00-7:00pm Sunday, 4/26
Attendance is mandatory for ALL dates and times
