- Qualified students in the College of Natural Sciences.

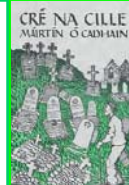

In 2003 Mel Gibson produced and directed the *PASSION OF THE CHRIST*. The film was provocative, generating controversy over everything from its historical and scriptural accuracy to charges of anti-Semitism and "gore-ography." However, its graphic images also evoked the drama and power of the Passion. Beginning February 28th and continuing through Lent we will examine some of the images from Gibson's film, the scriptures from which the images were inspired, and how those images speak to us as disciples of the cross.

MOTHER OLGA COMING TO THE NEWMAN CENTER

On Saturday, February 25th Mother Olga will be at the Newman Center to speak to students and non-students. Come and join us for the 9am Mass. We will have confessions available from 9:30 to 10am and then **Mother will speak from 10 to 11am.** Confessions will be heard again following the talk and all are welcome to have lunch in the Newman Center Café.

Mother Olga of the Sacred Heart, founder and mother servant of *Daughters of Mary of Nazareth*, was born and raised in Iraq. She lived through four wars. In 1993, as a young lay woman, she started a lay movement called *Love Your Neighbor*. She invited young men and women from Christian and Muslim communities to be part of this community to serve the needs of the poor in Iraq. In 1995 she established the order of Marth Maryam Sisters- *Missionaries of the Virgin Mary*, the first order for Religious Sisters in the Assyrian Church of the East in 700 years. In her homeland Mother Olga was involved in pastoral ministry for the college students and youth in the parishes throughout Iraq. She also served the prisoners, homeless, elderly, and handicapped of war for many years. The Iraqi government gave her *the Humanitarian Award* for her service to the poorest of the poor there. She came to the United States in 2001 for her studies where she received her M.A. in Pastoral Ministry from Boston College. From 2002- July 2011 she was involved in the campus ministry of the Catholic Center at Boston University.
