Overview:

The mission of the Mallinckrodt Foundation is to support **early stage investigators engaged in biomedical research** that has the potential to significantly advance the understanding, diagnosis, or treatment of disease. Funds are designed to provide support to move projects forward to the point where R01 or other independent funding can be obtained.

UMass Amherst may submit **one application** for this opportunity.

Eligibility:

- Candidates must be faculty members in the first to fourth year of a tenure-track position.
- Applicants with current R01 funding are ineligible.

Award Background:

- \$60,000/year for up to 3 years (**\$180,000** total)
- The foundation will not fund overhead/indirect costs. Salary is acceptable.
