**Definitions and Notes**

**Secondary Majors:** The actual count of undergraduate students whose secondary or tertiary major is in this school/college

**Undergraduate Total:** Undergraduate total represents a duplicated count of primary and secondary majors. Summing data for multiple departments may result in a duplicated headcount

**Total:** Unduplicated headcount of state supported and CPE majors. Prior to Fall 2003, duplication for some dual enrolled state-supported and CPE students may exist. Pre-majors are reported in the school/college and department of major.
