**Definitions and Notes**

**Available Tenure System Faculty (FTE):** Faculty with tenure or in a tenure track position. Excludes administrative faculty, faculty on leave without pay, and the percent of FTE paid from non-state/GOF funds.

**Teaching Tenure System Faculty (FTE):** Faculty from Available Tenure System who taught during the given semester.

**Non-tenure System Faculty (FTE):** Visiting, post-retirement, and temporary faculty teaching credit bearing sections; excludes the percent of FTE paid from non-state/GOF funds.

**Teaching Associates (FTE):** Teaching Associates (TOs) responsible for credit bearing sections. Instructor FTE is assigned in proportion to the credit value of the section where 1 FTE = 12 course credits.

**Other Instructors (FTE):** Others who teach such as campus administrators and staff, Five College faculty, and individuals who are not on the payroll. Sections with no instructors listed are also counted here except as described in note 3. Instructor FTE is assigned as described above for Teaching Associates.

**FTE Instructed Students (FTEIS):** Credits are divided by a full-time load to calculate full-time equivalency. For undergraduate courses, 1 FTE = 15 credit hours and for graduate courses, 1 FTE = 9 credit hours. For courses numbered 500-599, FTE depends on the level of the student: if undergraduate student, divide by 15; if graduate student, divide by 9. If multiple instructors are assigned to a course section, FTEIS are distributed proportionately to the instructors of record.

**Lower Division FTEIS:** FTE Instructed students generated in 100-level and 200-level courses.

**Upper Division FTEIS:** FTE Instructed students generated in 300-level and 400-level courses and 500-level if undergraduate students are enrolled.

**Graduate FTEIS:** FTE Instructed graduate students generated in 500-level courses and above.

Note 1: Course enrollments are reported as of the census date (14th calendar day). All data reflect the organizational structure as of Fall 2007.

Note 2: Instruction is reported according to the department in which the instructor of record is budgeted. Teaching Associates and "Other Instructors" are assigned based on the course rubric.

Note 3: Independent study, practica, and thesis and dissertation sections with no assigned instructor are attributed to "Teaching Tenure System Faculty".

Note 4: Instructor FTE and SCH are reported as an academic year average (the sum of fall and spring semesters divided by two).

Note 5: Undergraduate and graduate instruction administered through Continuing and Professional Education is not included.
