**OUTSTANDING CHAPTER MEMBER:

For all three, the following criteria should be considered:

- 1) Academic Record/GPA
- 2) Contribution to the chapter
- 3) Contribution to the greater fraternity/sorority movement on campus
- 4) Contribution to the greater campus community or Amherst community
- 5) Demonstrated leadership or potential for leadership
- 6) Demonstrated commitment to the fraternity movement and ideals

For each nominee, submit a one-two page, typed statement elaborating in the criteria being considered. A one page letter and a resume is also acceptable.

Each chapter nominee will be recognized at the Awards night. An outstanding recipient from each category will then be recognized.

OUTSTANDING FRATERNITY & SORORITY PHILANTHROPY PROGRAM

This award is given to the chapter that has demonstrated a commitment to campus and community service through its philanthropic efforts during the academic year. This award is to recognize the overall philanthropic/community service effort of the chapter, not just one event.
