The local chapter also provides a variety of social and intellectual activities for its members.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP:

- 1) At least 12 completed history credits (Advanced Placement, CLEP, etc. credits do not count)
- 2) The cumulative grade point average in completed history courses must be at least a **3.1**.
- 3) A **3.0** cumulative grade point average in ninety percent of the remaining non-history courses is also required.

***Transfer credit grades are counted in the Phi Alpha Theta average. Therefore a transcript listing your transfer grades must also be submitted.

For consideration for membership, the following need to be compiled, attached and submitted by March 1st to the History office, Herter 612 or Undergraduate History office Herter 613.

- 1) This application.
- 2) An unofficial transcript.
- 3) A check made out to HISTORY DEPARTMENT for \$55.00. This is for the international initiation and journal fee as well as support of our local chapter of Phi Alpha Theta.

If for any reason your application is NOT accepted, your check will be returned to you with a letter explaining the reason why you did not qualify. Once you are accepted, you will be notified by mail. The letter will contain further information about the time and place for the initiation ceremony.
