

**[HR-DDD] REMINDER: Pedestrian-only Zones to Begin April 6, 2008**

***Reminder: Pedestrian-only Zone Enforcement begins  
April 6, 2008***

Starting on Sunday, April 6, enforcement at the three "pedestrian-only" zones will begin. The first zone extends from the north side of the Whitmore Administration building to the northeast corner of Goodell; the second is located in the Campus Center area from the circle in the west to North Pleasant Street in the east; and the third runs from the north side of the West Experiment Station to Governors Drive. Access to these areas by most vehicles --private, delivery trucks, and non-emergency UMass vehicles --will be restricted. Alternate delivery and maintenance routes will be clearly marked. The UMass Police Department will enforce the restrictions.

This action is being taken to increase pedestrian safety, preserve the landscape, and improve the quality of campus life.

With the exception of emergency personnel, drivers of any vehicle requiring access to a pedestrian-only zone will first need to make arrangements through the UMass Police Department.
