

## **Information for Authors**

*The Journal for the History of Children and Youth* welcomes submissions of original article length manuscripts devoted to the historical experiences of children and young people without geographic or chronological limitations. All articles selected as appropriate will be anonymously peer-reviewed by experts in the author's field of study. The journal does not accept material that has been previously published or is under consideration for publication elsewhere. In general, manuscripts should be submitted in English with American usage and spelling but the journal also has a limited budget for translations. Please contact the editors if you would like to submit an article in a language other than English.

Articles submitted for publication should conform to the editorial standards outlined in *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 15<sup>th</sup> Edition using the humanities citation format ([http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\\_citationguide.html](http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html)). All text should be double spaced throughout, including endnotes and quotations, and should not exceed 10,000 words in length. All submissions should be made through Scholar One. The site will request author contact information, an abstract that details the argument and significance of the piece, jpeg or tiff images and full captions for any illustrations, a copy of your manuscript (preferably in Microsoft Word), and a precise word count. All identifying information should be removed from the manuscript prior to submission.
