# SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDY ABROAD

## Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen undergraduate student at a 2 or 4 year institution in the United States
- Applicant must be receiving a Federal Pell Grant at the time of application or during the term of study abroad
- Applicant must be applying to a study abroad program eligible for credit at the student's institution of higher education in the U.S.
- Applicant must be studying abroad for a minimum of 4 weeks in one country
- Study abroad program does not take place in Cuba or a country on the U.S. Department of State's Travel Warning list
- Study abroad program takes place in the fall, spring or academic year terms including winter intercessions. Summer only programs are not eligible

**THE GILMAN PROGRAM DIVERSIFIES THE KINDS OF STUDENTS WHO STUDY ABROAD AND THE COUNTRIES AND REGIONS WHERE THEY GO BY AWARDING 1,200 SCHOLARSHIPS OF UP TO \$5,000**

Students studying critical need languages are automatically considered for the Gilman Critical Need Language Supplement, which provides Gilman recipients with an additional \$3,000 for a total possible award of up to \$8,000
