Priority deadline is **December 15** for fall admission. Applications will be accepted until all seats are filled.

To apply, you must have a baccalaureate or master's degree in nursing, or an associate's degree in nursing and a non-Nursing baccalaureate degree from a nationally accredited school or college of nursing with a grade point average of 3.0 (B) or higher and a current professional license.
