Note 1. **Student Majors:** A student with a declared major within the school or college. At the undergraduate level, data reported represent a duplicated count of student majors (primary and secondary majors). FTE student majors are distributed proportionally across major programs. Therefore, numbers are not comparable to semesters prior to Fall 1995, which reported data for primary majors only. See Enrollment Definitions for additional details.

Note 2. **Active:** Matriculating graduate students registered for courses or dissertation credits.

Note 3. **Program Fee (PF):** Matriculating graduate students assigned three credits while on Program Fee (no course).

Note 4. **Primary Majors:** The actual count of undergraduate students whose primary declared major is in the school or college.

Note 5. **Secondary Majors:** The actual count of undergraduate students whose secondary or tertiary declared major is in the school or college.

Note 6. All data reflect the current organizational structure.

Note 7. Excludes undergraduate students on exchange at other institutions.

Note 8. Graduate numbers include students enrolled in the Division of Continuing Education.
