Definitions and Notes

Rate: The percent of applicants who were accepted (including either the preferred or alternate major at the undergraduate level).

Yield: The percent of accepted students who enrolled (including either the preferred or alternate major at the undergraduate level).

C.A.G.S. Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (School of Education only).

Note 1. All data reflect the current organizational structure.

Note 2. Includes students enrolled in at least one credit-bearing course at the end of the fourteenth calendar day of the semester.

Note 3. Information is reported according to the School or College affiliation of the major to which the student **applied** (at the undergraduate level, the preferred major).

Note 4. Some academic units have restricted the number of entering students, and many applicants are offered an alternative major. In the majority of cases, the alternate acceptance and enrollment figures do not represent acceptance or enrollment into that school or college, but acceptance or enrollment as an "Undeclared" major.

Note 5. Effective Fall 2003 pre-majors are reported in the school/college and department of major.

Note 6. In Fall 2003, there were 408 applications, 370 acceptances, and 287 enrollments in graduate CE administered programs.
