Note B. **International:** Students holding a visa are given the "international" designation and pay out-of-state tuition. Those students with refugee or alien registration status are classified as in-state or out-of-state depending on their state of residence.

Note C. **Exchange:** Students who are full-time students from other colleges and universities on exchange at University of Massachusetts Amherst through one of several national and international exchange programs. Each program has a different tuition payment agreement.

Note D. Individual percentage entries may not sum to 100.0 because of rounding.

Note E. Graduate numbers include continuing education.
