Note A. **Regional:** Students who are legal residents of the other New England states and enrolled in a degree program at the University of Massachusetts Amherst that is not offered at the students' own state institutions.

Note B. **International:** Students holding a visa are given the "international" designation and pay out-of-state tuition. Those students with refugee or alien registration status are classified as in-state or out-of-state depending on their state of residence.

Note C. **Exchange:** Students who are full-time undergraduate students from other colleges and universities on exchange at University of Massachusetts Amherst through one of several national and international exchange programs. Each program has a different tuition payment agreement.

Note D. Individual percentage entries may not sum to 100.0 because of rounding.

Note E. Graduate numbers include students enrolled in Continuing and Professional Education. Undergraduate numbers exclude Continuing and Professional Education.
