Note C. Numbers include students enrolled in programs administered by Continuing and Professional Education (CPE), including off-campus and on-line programs.

Note D. New federal race/ethnicity standards allow individuals to specify more than one race. In addition, some categories have been renamed, Asian and Pacific Islander categories were split, and "Two or More Races" was added. Hispanic or Latino of any race includes students who may have been previously counted in other groups.

Therefore, data from fall 2010 forward are not comparable to previous years.
