### Study Manuals Needed

All attendees should bring the current Pesticide Applicator Core Manual (2<sup>nd</sup> ed.), the Massachusetts Core Supplement (2000), the Massachusetts Pesticide Control Act (May 2000), and the Massachusetts Pesticide Regulations (March 2007). These are the study manuals that you will need to take the applicator license exam.

### Special Accommodations

Please contact the Pesticide Education office as soon as possible if you require any special accommodations for the two-day workshop.

### Refunds

There will be no refunds in the event that an individual cannot attend a workshop. Instead, another individual may take his/her place, or he/she can attend another workshop (provided that there is enough room).
