



## Department of Plant, Soil & Insect Sciences Entomology Undergraduate and Graduate Scholarships

### Richardson Fund (Scholarship)

- **Purpose:** Needy and deserving **Undergraduate Student** in junior year for assistance in their senior year to work with a faculty member in the Plant, Soil & Insect Sciences Entomology Division. If student is not in their junior year, the award can only be made in 1 out of 5 years. Not restricted to U.S. Citizens, but they have preference.
- **Award:** \$2,200 to a student meeting the above criteria is available for the 2005 academic year, which may include the summer.
- **Nominations:** A faculty member must recommend the student and write them a letter of recommendation. If the nomination being made involves working in the faculty's research program, the nomination must be accompanied by a description of how the student fits into the program. It would strengthen the nomination if the student would also submit a C.V.
- **Deadline:** Nominations are due by **April 30<sup>th</sup> Each Year.**

### Shaw Fund

- **Purpose:** Restricted to the purchase of textbooks for needy students.
- **Award:** Up to \$520.00 in support of textbook purchases to a student working with a faculty member in the Plant, Soil & Insect Sciences Entomology Division.
- **Nominations:** A faculty member of the Entomology Division must recommend in writing the student and explain how the student relates to the teaching/research program of the division.
- **Deadline:** Nominations are due by **April 30<sup>th</sup> Each Year.**

### Rosenfeld Fund

- **Purpose:** This award shall be made each year to 2 students with outstanding work in applied entomology. Candidates must be **Graduate Students** in the Plant, Soil & Insect Sciences Entomology Division and must submit evidence of a completed research project. The evidence could be completion of a degree with the thesis or dissertation serving as the evidence and/or evidence that the research is being considered for publication (submitted or in press) or as a reprint.
- **Award:** \$500 to one or two students from the Entomology Division working in the area of applied entomology.
- **Nominations:** A faculty member of the Entomology Division must recommend the student and with the student put together the supporting evidence (see above purpose) along with the student's C.V.
- **Deadline:** Nominations are due by **April 30<sup>th</sup> Each Year.**
