

Unrestricted grants carry an indirect cost rate of 10% TDC for any award \$1000 or more. The F&A is assessed in all cases. In order to be classified as an unrestricted grant, the faculty members must be free to use the funds in any way that benefits the University by supporting their general research interests. They differ from regular grants and contracts in that there can be no formal requirements by the sponsor for financial or technical reports and the sponsor has no claim whatsoever to any intellectual property rights that may result from projects supported by unrestricted grants. Because of the unrestricted nature of the project, it is anticipated that there is no attributed level of effort on behalf of the PI. If the PI feels that a level of effort is required, the PI must report that level of effort to OGCA and the award letter must provide the sponsors acknowledgement and approval that the PI use this money for appropriate salary per University guidelines.
