Subject: GEO Graduate Curriculum Fee Waiver Rates Advance Notification Rates to be Effective July 1, 2006

Please be advised that effective July 1, 2006, the curriculum fee rate for all GEO appointments charged back to grants (including federal appropriation accounts) and gifts will increase.

The effective rates are determined by competitive proposal date, as follows:

The following graduate appointment types are included:

Research Assistant (RA)
Project Assistant (PA)
Teaching Appointments (TA and TO)
Interns (IN)
Working Fellows (FU) - NB: **non**-working fellows and **non**-working trainees are excluded from the waiver charge back.

The rate is calculated from actual 2006 participation data and expected FY 2007 graduate curriculum fees.

It is also calculated on the basis of one FTE equal to 760 hours of employment for the year. All applicable fall and spring appointments will be calculated as a percentage of this FTE.

The charge back rate is applicable from the first Sunday in September through the last Saturday in May. The fee charges are not subject to Indirect Cost Charges, and are not applicable to appointments on department and P.I. RTF accounts.

Charges for fiscal 2007 will be assessed to all accounts monthly beginning in September, 2006, using object code 786900. If you have any questions, please call or email.
