Herbert L. Forest Scholarship

A scholarship to honor the late Herbert L. Forest, a distinguished alumnus of the Department of Resource Economics at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, was established by his friends and admirers on the occasion of his retirement. Mr. Forest served as Director of the Dairy Division of the Agricultural Marketing Service of the United States Department of Agriculture for most of his career. He supervised the establishment and operation of Federal Milk Marketing Orders throughout the United States and was also involved in numerous international negotiations related to trade in dairy products. Mr. Forest died during 1993. Since his death, the Herbert L. Forest Scholarship fund has continued to benefit significantly from the contributions of his family, friends, and admirers. The scholarship fund presently provides a \$2000 award per academic year.

REQUIREMENTS: An applicant must be a junior or senior next fall majoring in Resource Economics, Veterinary and Animal Sciences, or Food Science to be eligible for the Herbert L. Forest Scholarship. At the request of Mr. Forest, preference is given to applicants with a demonstrated career interest in government service with some additional preference for interest in government service related to dairy marketing. In addition to career plans, criteria for selection include academic standing and, secondarily, financial need. To apply, please submit the application on the next page.

Applications are due by May 1, 2010.
