### Ansin Study Abroad Fellowship 2008 Scholarship Information

Ronald Ansin and his family established the Ansin Study Abroad Fellowship in 1999. Mr. Ansin is the father of two UMass Amherst alumni, Ken '87 and Bob '96, who were both political science majors. This award helps undergraduates to live and study overseas. Since its inception, the Ansin Study Abroad Fellowship has provided scholarships to more than 170 individuals.

**Eligibility:** All College of Social and Behavior Sciences majors who wish to study abroad are eligible to receive a fellowship to help offset some expenses.

**Selection:** Based on financial need and/or academic excellence, a committee chooses recipients in the spring semester for the following summer, fall or yearlong program. Approximately 20 fellowships are given annually; awards typically range from \$500 - \$2,000.

**Deadline to apply: Friday April 18, 2008**

- *Attend the scholarship reception on Saturday, May 10, 2008.*
