Pursuant to the procedure for the quadrennial review of General Education courses, established in Senate Document No. 85-024, the General Education Council reviewed the course which is now known as COINS 187, Programming with Data Structures, an Analytic Reasoning (R2) course. The course was originally approved as COINS 123, Introduction to Problem Solving with Computers. The name and number were changed through the standard minor course change mechanism. In the process of its quadrennial review of the course, the General Education Council concluded that the course content had changed substantially since the course was first approved for General Education credit as COINS 123. The Council determined that the alterations were of such a significant nature that the renewal of the designation as though it were for the same course as originally approved would not be appropriate. The Council also concluded that the course as now constituted, COINS 187, is appropriate for the Analytic Reasoning (R2) designation, but that it should be brought forward to the Senate as a new proposal for designation, rather than being treated by the Council as renewal of an existing designation.
