**Position:** The successful applicant will join a growing graduate program and faculty in Environmental Health Sciences. Current areas of faculty research in the program include environmental exposure assessment, dose-response modeling, environmental epigenetics, and assessment/remediation of chemical contamination in soils and sediments. Candidates will be expected to establish an outstanding independent research program, participate in graduate education and advising, and provide leadership in the Division and Department of Public Health. The successful applicant will have the opportunity to engage in collaborative research with faculty from the Department of Public Health, the School of Public Health and Health Sciences, other departments on campus, Pioneer Valley Life Sciences Institute, the Institute for Global Health, the University of Massachusetts Medical School, Baystate Medical Center, and others. An attractive start-up package and a competitive, state-supported salary have been committed.

**Qualifications:** Successful candidates for this position must have a doctorate in environmental health sciences, public health or a related field. Preference will be given to candidates who have post-doctoral experience, have demonstrated strong evidence of an externally-funded research program, independent and collaborative research potential, interest and ability in teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels, and a record of peer reviewed publications commensurate with experience and rank. While candidates with research interests in any area of Environmental Health Science will be considered, the Division is particularly interested in candidates with established population-based cohorts, with active research and teaching programs in one or more of the following fields:

- Environmental Epidemiology
- Systemic or Molecular Toxicology
- Global Environmental Health

**Applications:** The deadline for applications is November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011; a fall 2012 start date is anticipated.
