As of FY2018, the campus began to phase in a tuition charge structure that would bring the tuition charge on grants in line with our peers and equal to 100% of in-state graduate tuition. Grants and contracts with a proposal date prior to July 1, 2017 will continue to see an annual increase of 5% to their tuition charge until the charge is equal to the in-state graduate tuition rate (\$13,368 per GEO FTE for FY2023). The FY2023 Academic Year GEO Graduate Tuition charge to grants with a proposal date of July 1, 2017 or later will increase to \$15,148 per GEO FTE, the FY23 In-State Graduate Tuition Rate.
