

**SENIOR CITIZEN TUITION CREDIT AFFIDAVIT**

For Commonwealth Residents 60 Years of Age or Over

Chapter 15A of the General Laws provides that there shall be no charge for tuition to **any Massachusetts resident sixty years of age or over** attending a state college, regional community college, or the University of Massachusetts, if the institution which said person attends is not overenrolled. The University of Massachusetts Senior Citizen Tuition Credit Affidavit credits up to \$857 toward tuition per semester for students enrolled in an undergraduate program and up to \$1320 for students enrolled in a graduate program per semester. This affidavit **cannot** be used towards courses offered through Continuing and Professional Education. You will be responsible for all fees resulting from your enrollment. Students enrolled in five (5) or more credits are required to be covered under a comprehensive health insurance plan. Students who have their own health insurance may waive this fee online.

**AFFIDAVIT**
