

Sample schedule for Incoming Transfer Econ major (15-17 credits):

- Transfer section of Intermediate Macroeconomics (Econ 204) or another appropriate Econ class
- One Upper level Econ class (numbered 205 and above) – 3-4 credits
- One Math class (usually Math 128 or 132) – 3 or 4 credits
- University Transfer Seminar (UNIV 125T) – 1 credit
- An International/Intercultural class or Minor-related class – 3-4 credits

Your individual schedule will depend on a number of factors including:

- Prior courses in Economics and Calculus. If either Introductory Microeconomics or Introductory Macroeconomics have NOT been completed at previous university, then they must be taken before any upper level classes are taken. We strongly encourage students who have taken both introductory courses and Calculus 1 to enroll in the transfer section of Econ 204.
- Math Placement Scores, if you have not completed Calculus 1
- If you have remaining General Education requirements to finish, you will substitute an economics class for a GenEd
- Your interests and preferences

Recommendations:

- Your advisor will help you choose the classes that best fit your situation
- We encourage students to add classes they are interested in to their SPIRE Shopping Cart prior to the meeting with your advisor.
