Accreditation

The first Professional BSLA degree at the University of Massachusetts is accredited by the Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB). LAAB granted a 6-year accreditation term, ends Fall 2022. The most recent review was in Fall 2016 and the next accreditation review is scheduled for Fall of 2022.
