New Orleans' Second Line Quarter

The Second Line Quarter is a powerful vision of a revitalized New Orleans community and a diverse collective spirit which inherits the Big Easy traditions of hospitality, creativity, and resiliency. Nestled between the French Quarter, the neighborhood of Treme, and the heartbeat of New Orleans, Canal Street, the Quarter celebrates the richness, energy, and excitement that the surrounding "main-line" urban forces offer.

The Second Line Quarter offers a diversity of new spaces for livability, commerce, and social interaction in New Orleans. As a whole, it describes an innovative and "improvisational" mix of neighborhood spaces and uses characterized by a resilient, sustainable neighborhood and a free-flowing mix of residential, retail, office and studio spaces overlooking walk-able green streets. The design significantly strengthens the overall community's vibrancy and improves urban ecosystem resiliency against natural disturbances.
