







In spring 2018, OAPA, SACL, and OIR researchers collaborated to design an in-house replacement for the longstanding *CIRP Freshman Survey*. The 2018 *Entering First Year Student Survey* was administered during summer New Student Orientation (June-July) to the vast majority of domestic first year students. International first year students were invited to complete an online version of the survey in late August. The overall response rate for the new, much briefer survey was 85% (n=4259). This report presents overall results for selected survey items. Results are shown separately for women (W) and men (M) if the difference between groups is ten or more percentage points.




Current religious preference:




Political views:
