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



In spring 2018, OAPA, SACL, and OIR researchers collaborated to design an in-house replacement for the longstanding *CIRP Freshman Survey*. The 2018 *Entering First-Year Student Survey* was administered during summer New Student Orientation (June-July) to the vast majority of domestic first-year students. International first-year students were invited to complete an online version of the survey in late August. The overall response rate for the new, much briefer survey was 85% (n=4259). This report presents university-wide results for selected survey items, followed by College/School-specific results. Results are shown separately for women (W) and men (M) if the difference between groups is ~ten or more percentage points.




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

How students spent their time during a typical week of high school senior year:




How students spent their time during a typical week of high school senior year:




(ENG top five includes “watching TV or videos” (7.0 hrs))





(HFA top five includes "watching TV or videos" (7.7 hrs))




(CICS top five includes "Gaming" (6.3 hrs) & "Watching TV or videos (7.8 hrs))




How students spent their time during a typical week of high school senior year:




How students spent their time during a typical week of high school senior year:




(SBS top five includes "Watching TV or videos" (7.1 hrs))




(ISOM top five includes "Watching TV or videos" (7.3 hrs))



