## Definitions and Notes.

This report is divided into seven sections. The first section reports on all Massachusetts Community College transfers who applied to the University of Massachusetts Amherst. Sections 2-7 report the data for select Massachusetts community colleges: Berkshire, Greenfield, Holyoke, Springfield Technical, Mount Wachusett, and Quinsigamond Community Colleges. This report **includes** students who applied to programs administered by Continuing and Professional Education (e.g. University Without Walls).

**Tables 1 & 2.** Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments by Sending Institution. Number of students who applied, accepted and enrolled through the transfer admission process from each MA community college.

**Figure 1.** Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments. The number of students who applied, accepted and enrolled through the transfer admission process from fall 2015 through spring 2020.

**Figure 2.** Entering Students by School/College of Major. The number of transfer students who enrolled according to the school or college of their major.

**Figure 3.** Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Sex and Full-Time Status. The number of students who entered in the fall or spring semester. Full-time—student enrolled for 12 or more credits.

**Figure 4.** Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity. The proportion of students in each racial/ethnic category. The percentages are based on the number of U.S. citizens (or immigrants) who report race/ethnicity. Excludes students who do not report race/ethnicity. Self-report of race/ethnicity is voluntary. Underrepresented minority (URM) includes American Indian/Alaska Native, Black/African American, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic Latino, and those who declared multiple race/ethnicities (except Asian and White).

**Figure 5.** Entering Transfers by Admissions Type and Level. The number of students who entered as part of a Joint Admission/MassTransfer articulation agreement and those who entered through the normal transfer admission process. Also reports the number of students who entered as upper division (57 or more credits) and those who entered as lower division (fewer than 57 credits).

**Figure 6.** Entering and First-Year GPA of Full-time MassTransfer Students. The GPA earned at the sending community college and GPA at the end of the first year at UMass Amherst. Numbers reported for students who entered as part of the Joint Admissions/MassTransfer program.

**Figure 7.** One-Year Retention of Full-time MassTransfer Students. The percentage of students who entered in a fall semester and returned or graduated after the first year. Students who withdrew are assigned to one of two categories—those withdrawing with a cumulative grade point average of greater than or equal to 2.0 (the GPA required to be in good academic standing), or less than 2.0. Data are reported for Joint Admissions/MassTransfer students only. Number of students in each entering cohort (No. Entering) is also reported. The data for Berkshire, Mount Wachusett, and Quinsigamond Community Colleges are not represented graphically because the numbers are too small to draw meaningful comparisons from year to year.

**Figure 8.** Graduation Rates of Full-time MassTransfer Students. The percentage of students who graduated in 2, 3, 4 or more than 4 years from fall semester of entry. Percentages are cumulative. Number of students in each entering cohort (No. Entering) is also shown. The data for Berkshire, Mount Wachusett, and Quinsigamond Community Colleges are not represented graphically because the numbers are too small to draw meaningful comparisons from year to year.

**Figures 9-12.** These figures are presented for all Massachusetts community colleges. Numbers are too small to display by individual institution. Number of students in each entering cohort (No. Entering) is also reported.

**Figure 9.** One-Year Retention of Full-time Non-MassTransfer Students. The percentage of students who entered in a fall semester and returned or graduated after the first year. Students who withdrew are assigned to one of two categories—those withdrawing with a cumulative grade point average of greater than or equal to 2.0 (the GPA required to be in good academic standing), or less than 2.0. Data are reported for Non-Joint Admissions/Non-MassTransfer students only. Number of students in each entering cohort (No. Entering) is also reported.

**Figure 10.** Graduation Rates of Full-time Non-MassTransfer Admits. The percentage of students who graduated in 2, 3, 4 or more than 4 years from point of entry. Percentages are cumulative. Data are reported for Non-Joint Admissions/Non-MassTransfer students only.

**Figure 11.** Graduation Rates of Full-time MassTransfer Students with Entering GPA of less than 3.0. The percentage of full-time Joint Admit/MassTransfer students who graduated in 2, 3, 4 or more than 4 years from point of entry who entered with a transfer GPA of less than 3.0. Percentages are cumulative.

**Figure 12.** Graduation Rates of Full-time MassTransfer Students with Entering GPA 3.0 or above. The percentage of full-time Joint Admit students who graduated in 2, 3, 4 or more than 4 years from point of entry who entered with a transfer GPA of 3.0 and above. Percentages are cumulative.

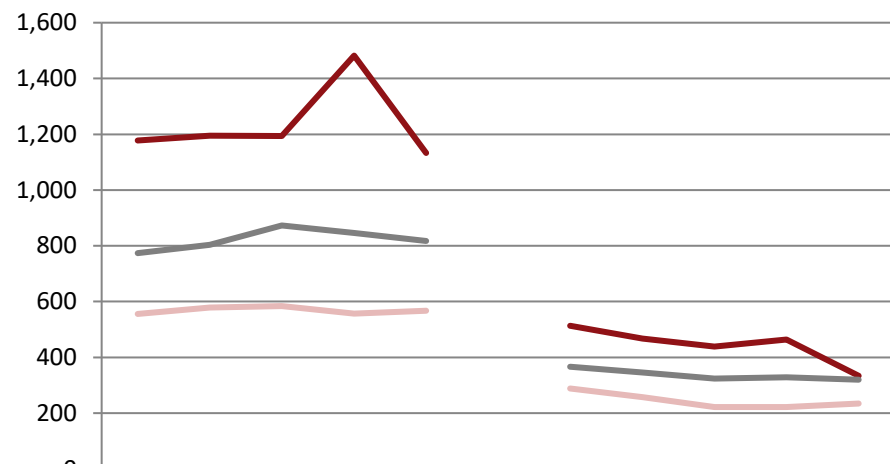

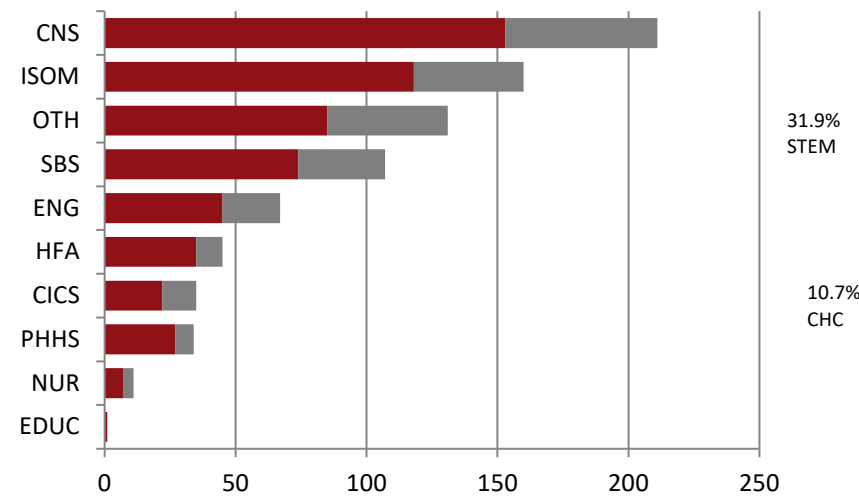

**Fig. 1 Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20**

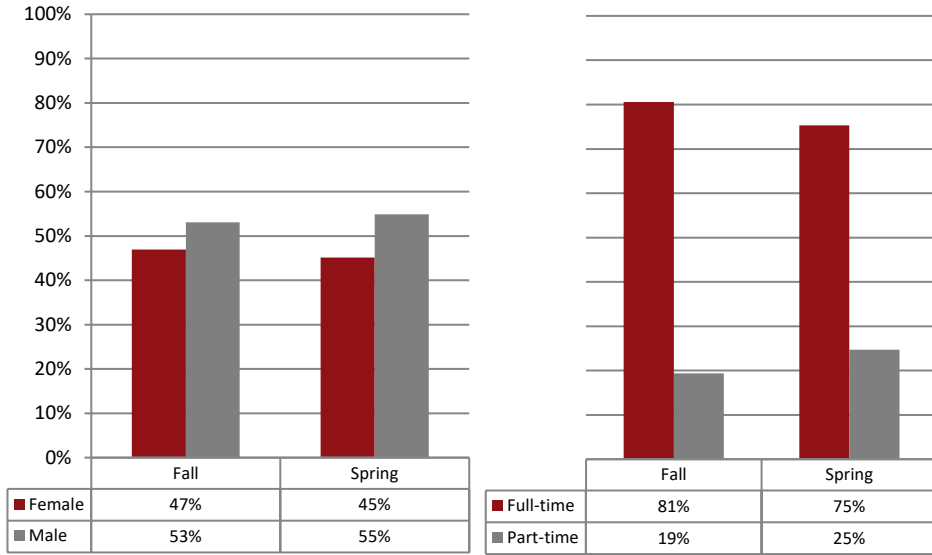


**Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-20**

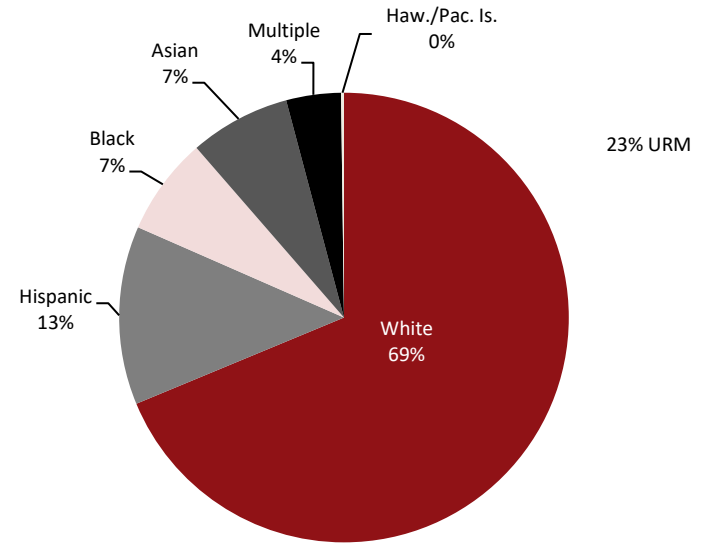

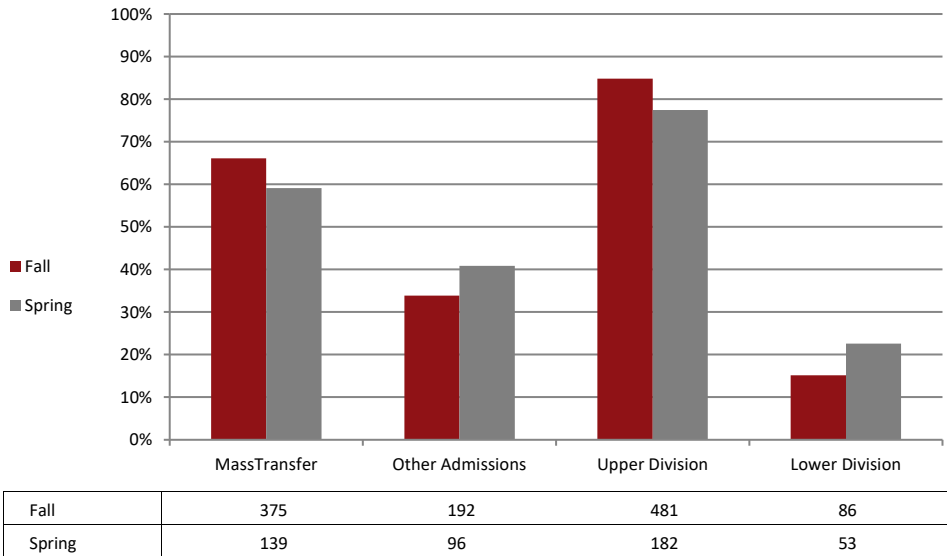
**Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status  
Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**



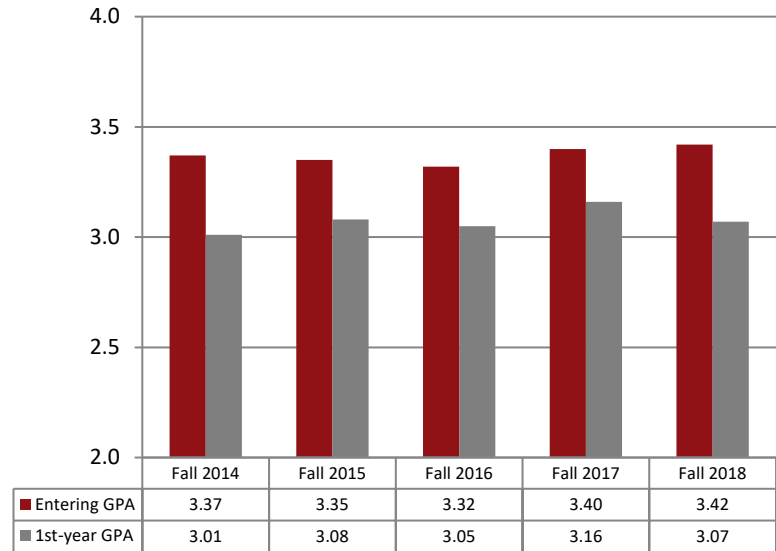
**Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**



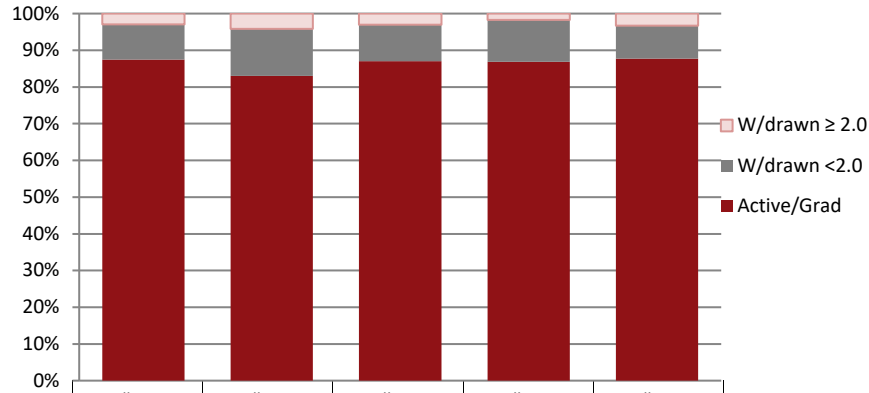
**Fig. 6 Entering and First-Year GPA of Full-time MasTransfer Students

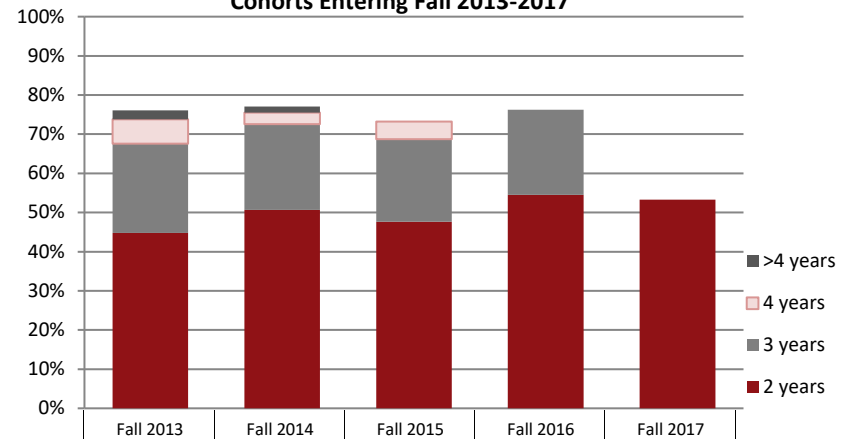

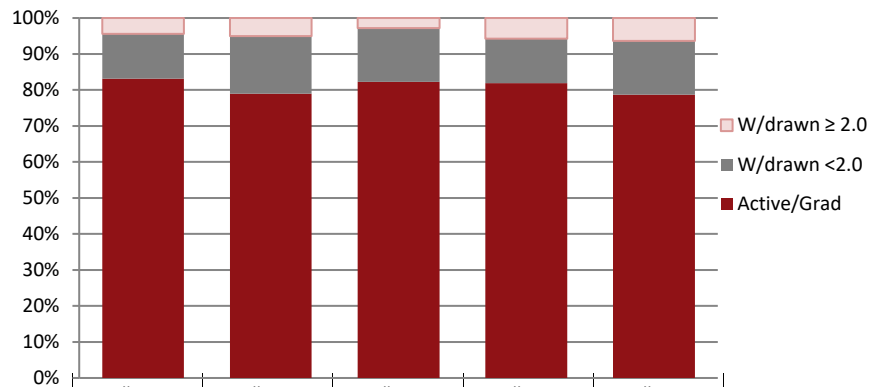
**Graduation Rates of Full-time MassTransfer Students Cohorts Entering Fall 2013-2017**

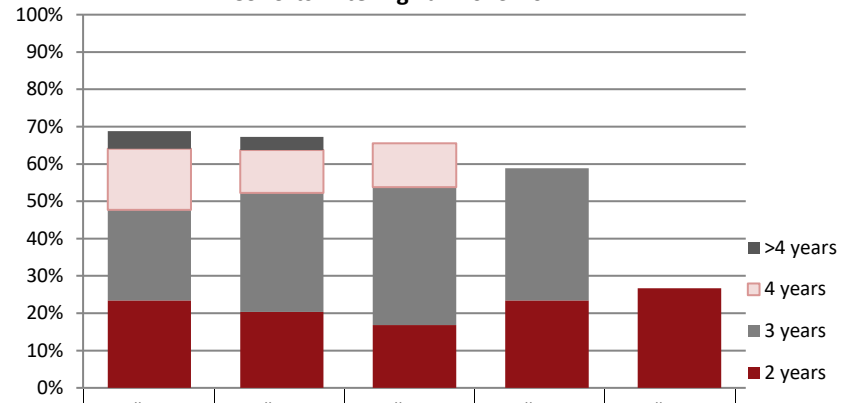
**One-Year Retention of Full-time Non-MassTransfer Students Cohorts Entering Fall 2014-2018**

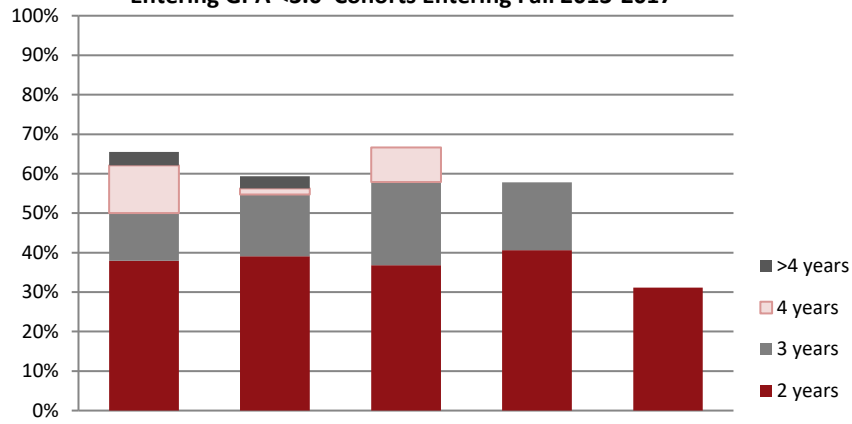
**Graduation Rates of Full-time Non-MassTransfer Admits Cohorts Entering Fall 2013-2017**

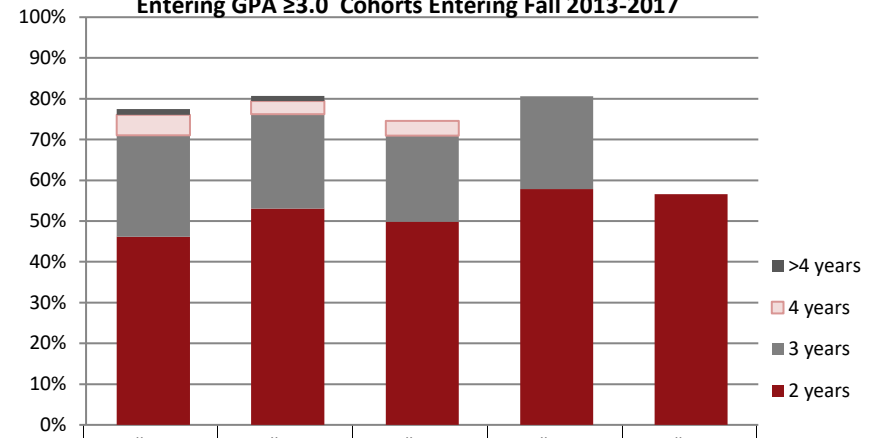

Fig. 1 Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20

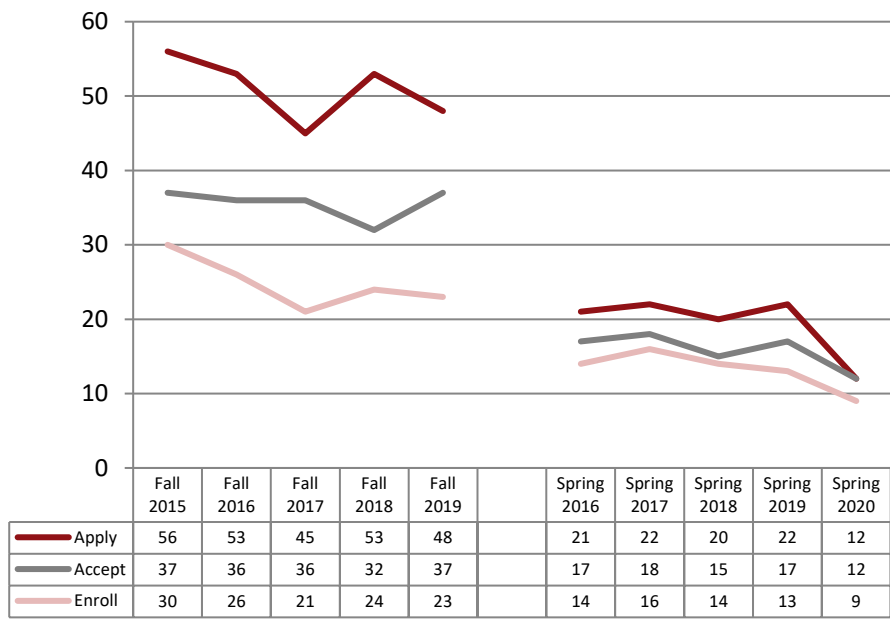


Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-20

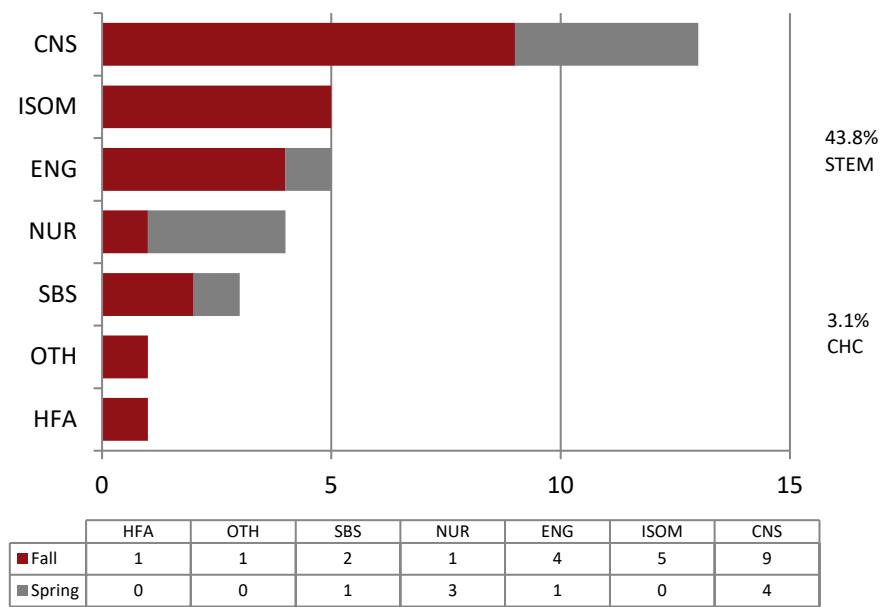


Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status Fall 2019 - Spring 2020

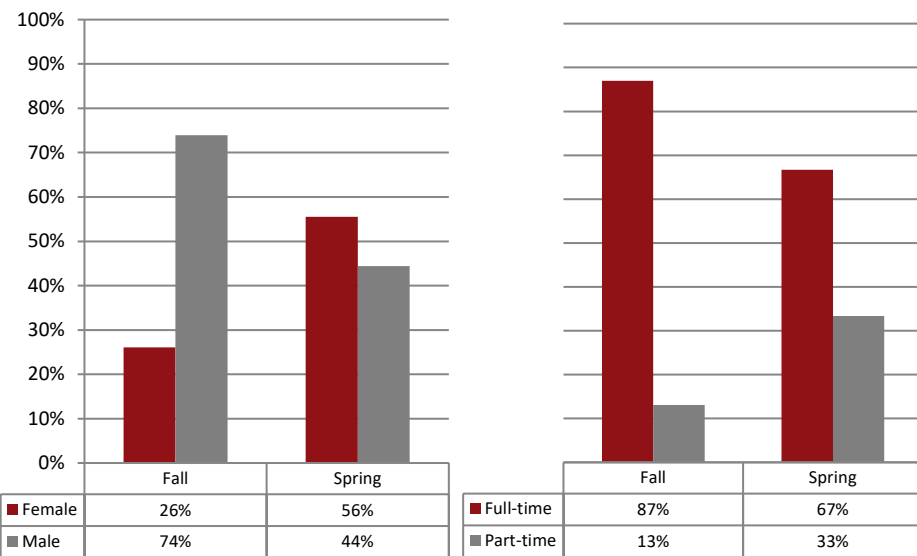
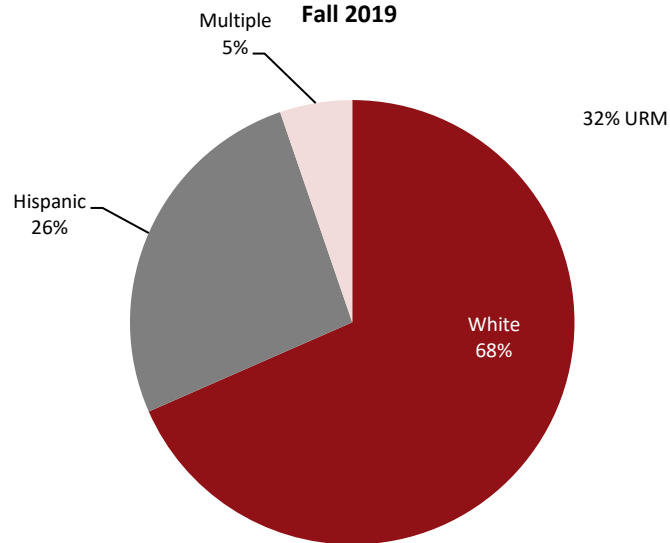


Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity Fall 2019

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**

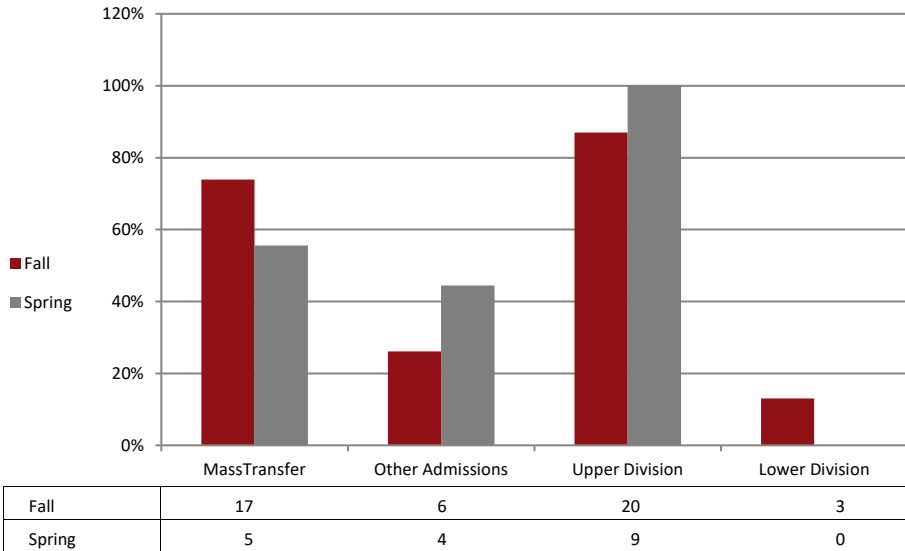


Fig. 6 **Entering and First-Year GPA of Full-time MassTransfer Students  
Entering Fall 2014-2018**

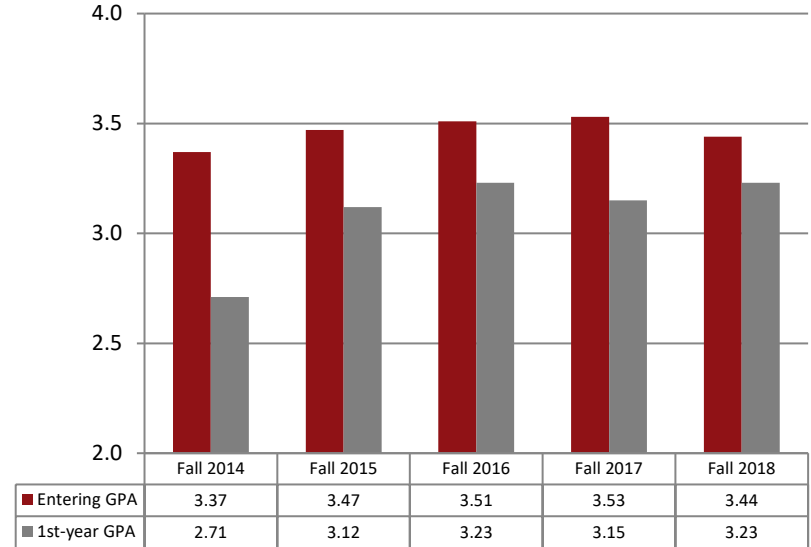


Fig. 7 **One Year Retention of Full-Time MassTransfer Students  
Cohorts Entering Fall 2013-2018**

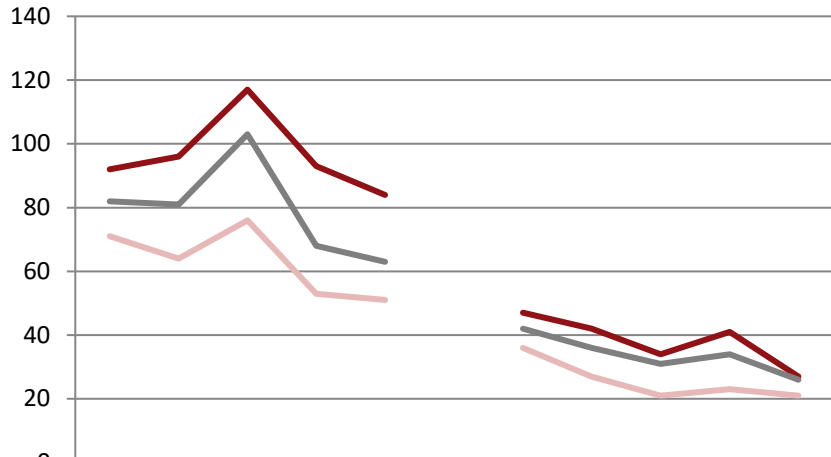

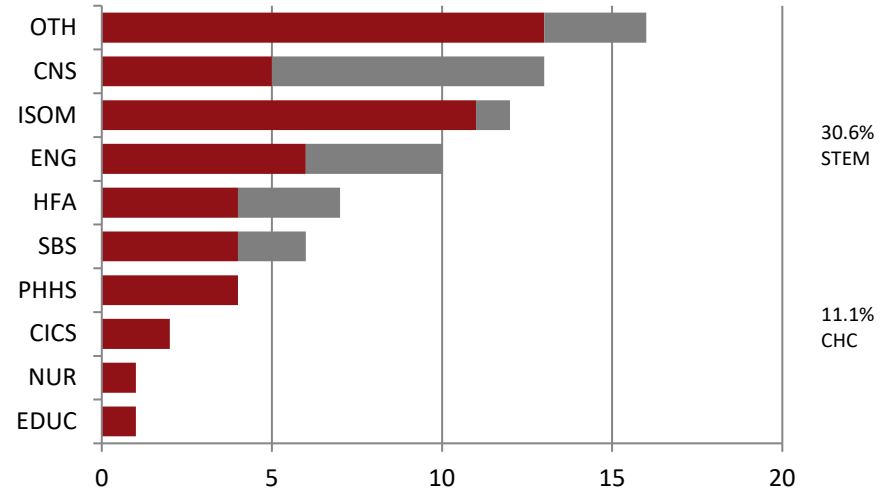

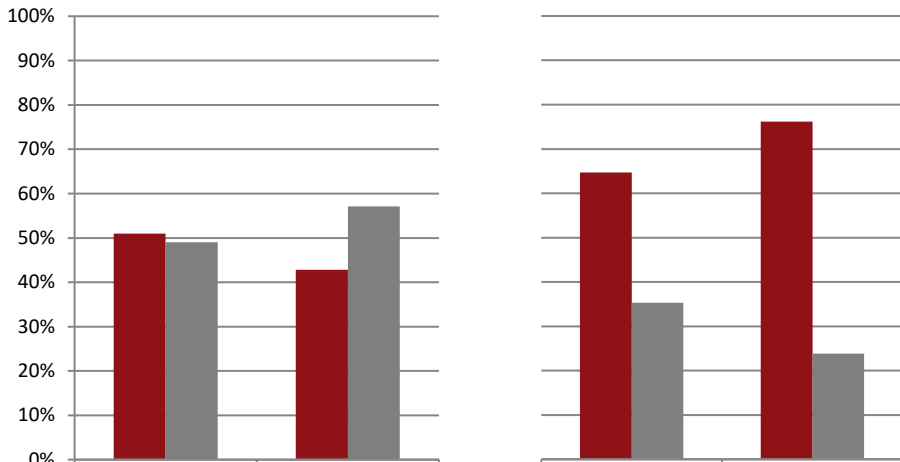
Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-20

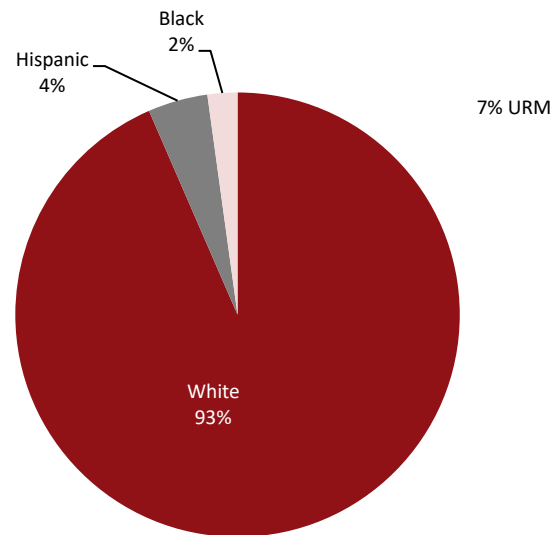

Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status Fall 2019 - Spring 2020



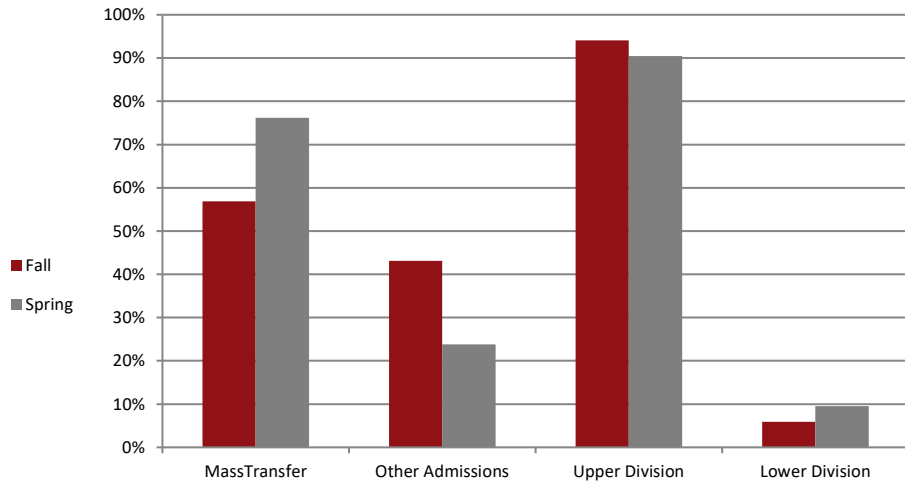

Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity Fall 2019



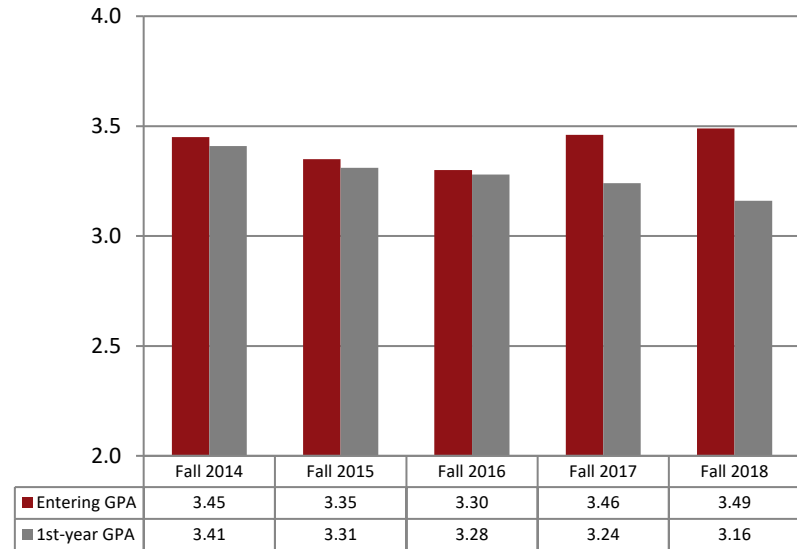

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**



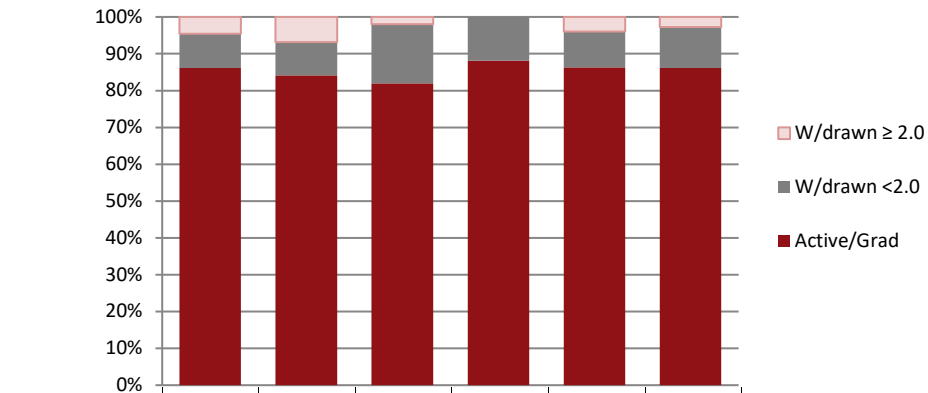

Entering Fall 2014-2018**



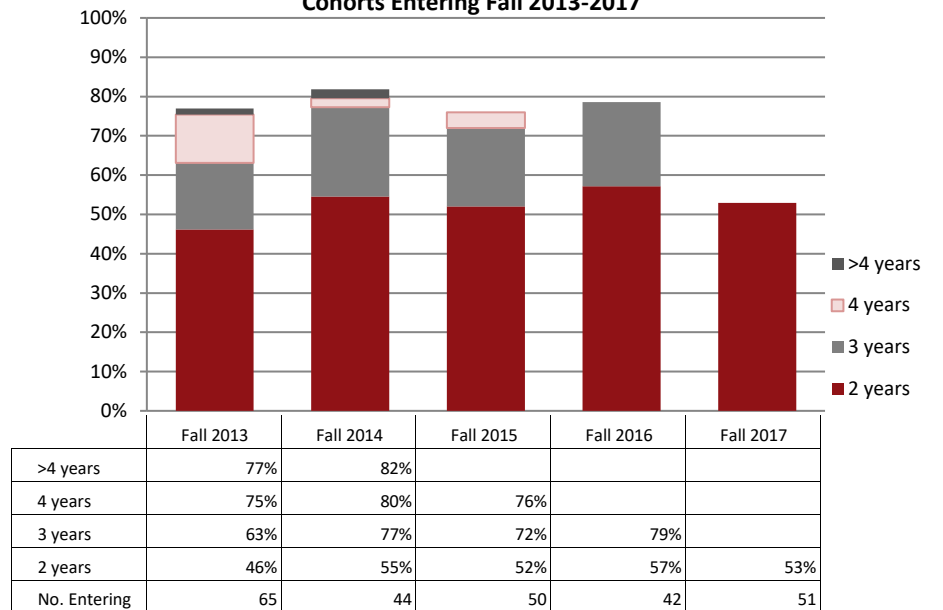

Fig. 1 Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20

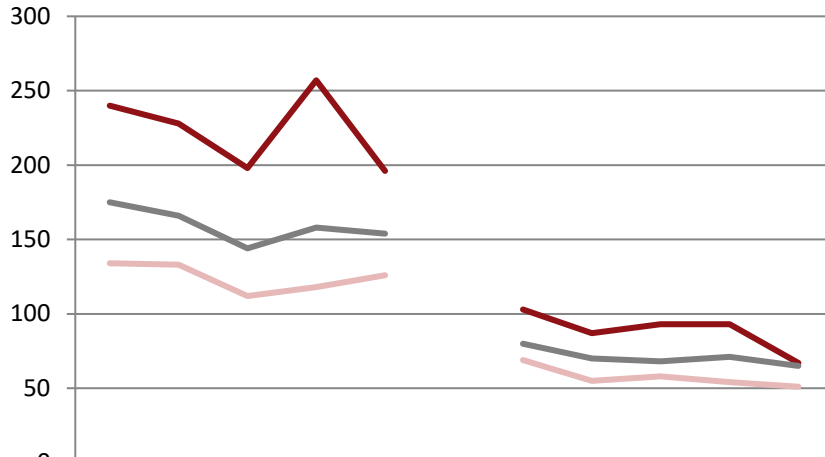


Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-20

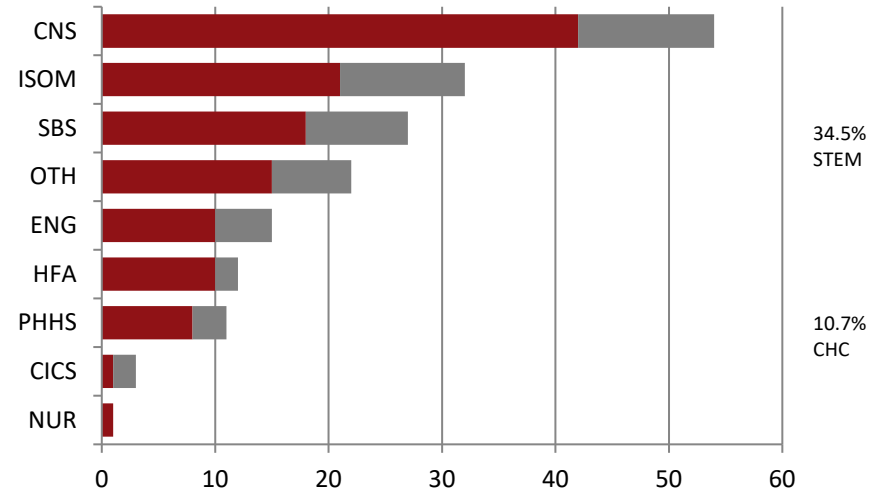


Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status Fall 2018 - Spring 2019

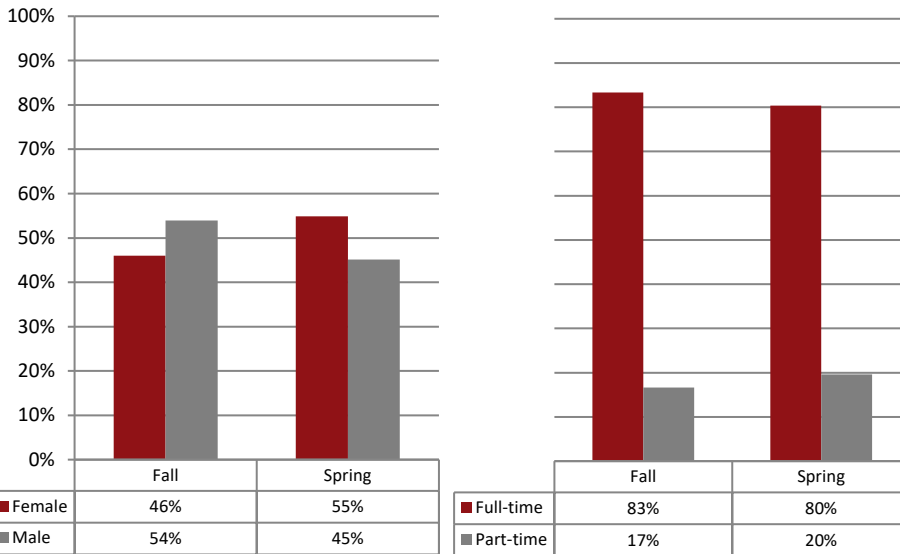
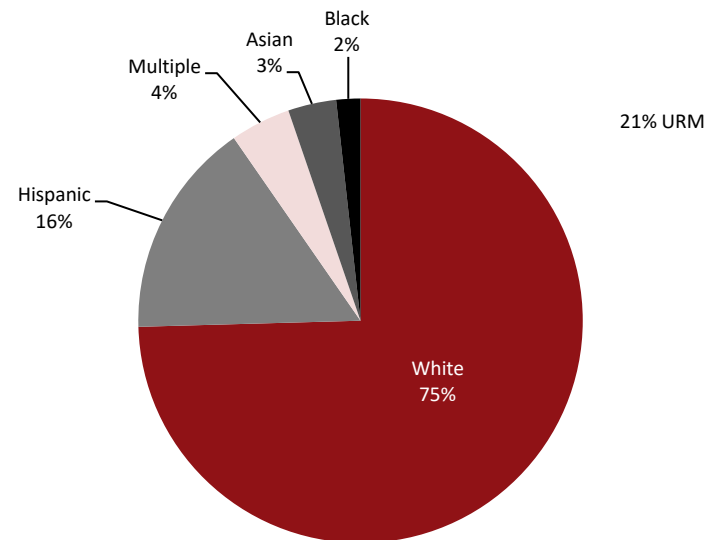
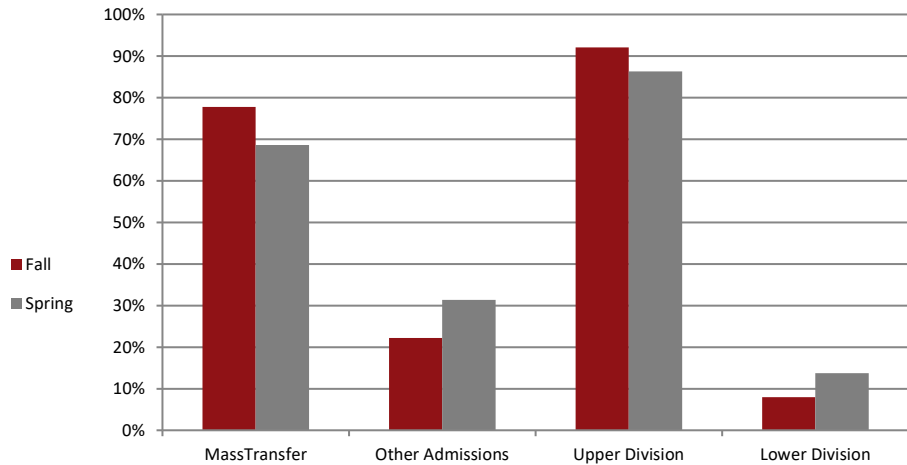


Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity Fall 2019

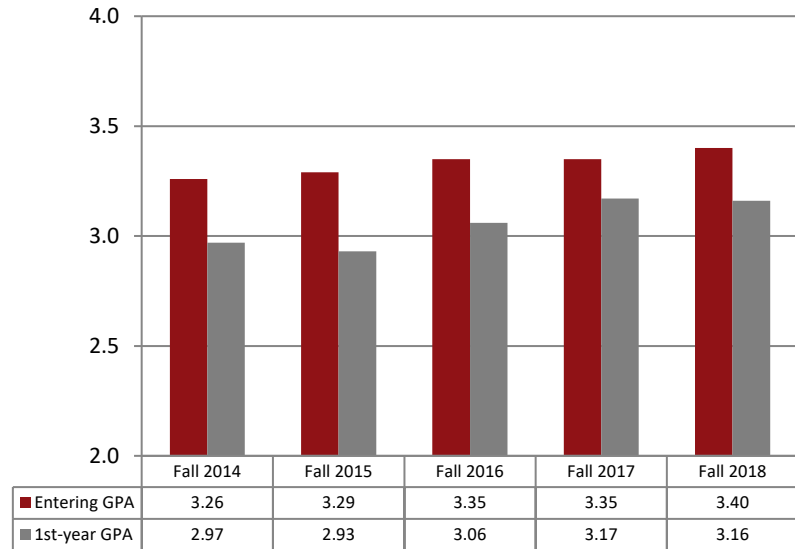
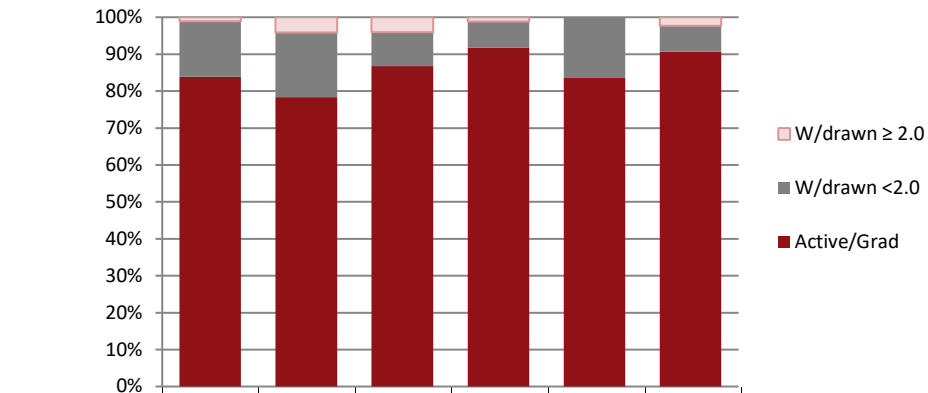
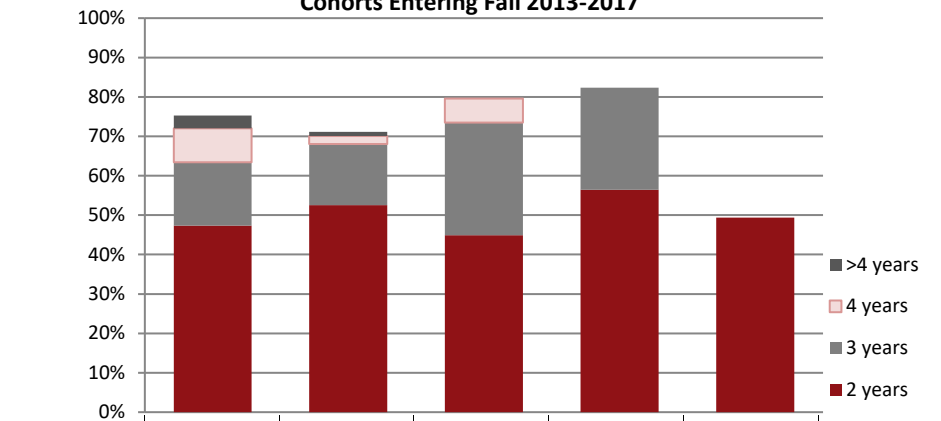


Fig. 7 **One-Year Retention of Full-time MassTransfer Students**

Fig. 1 Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20

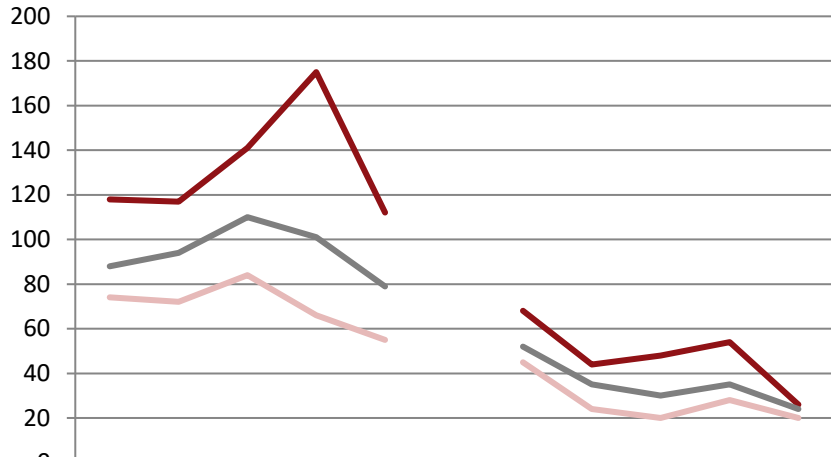


Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-2020

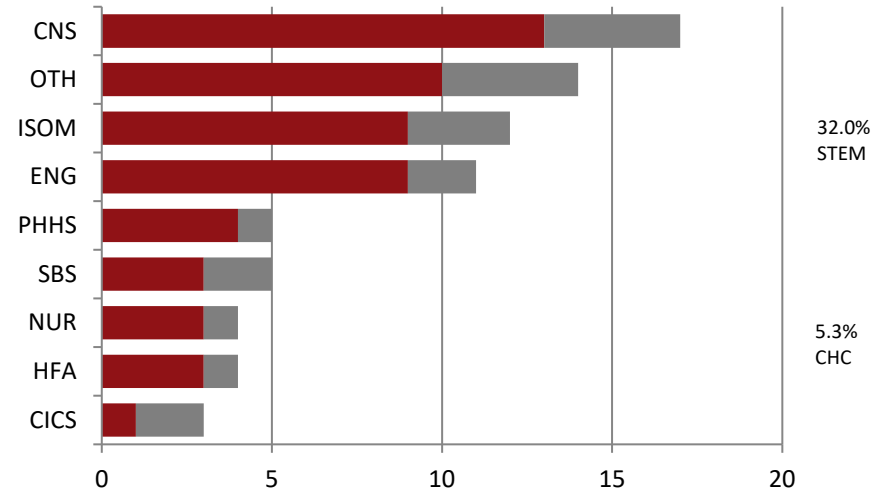


Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status Fall 2019 - Spring 2020

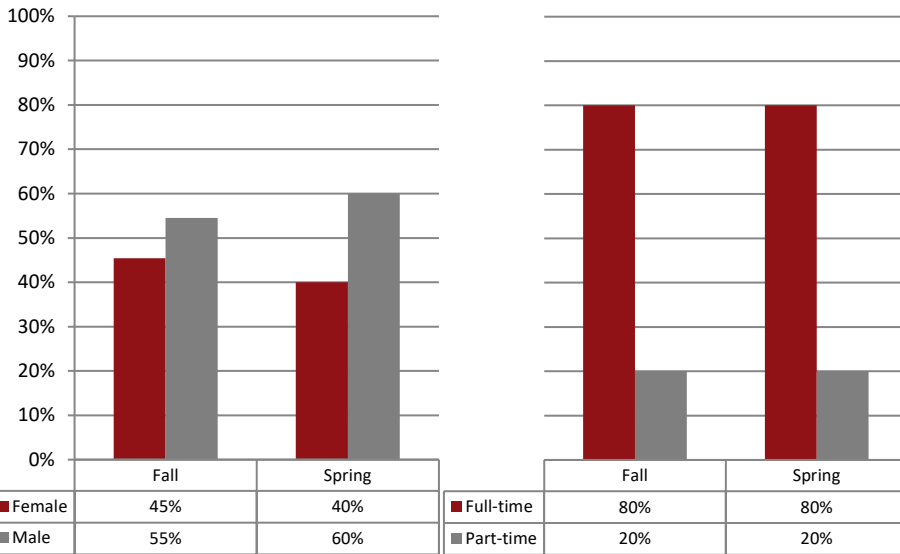
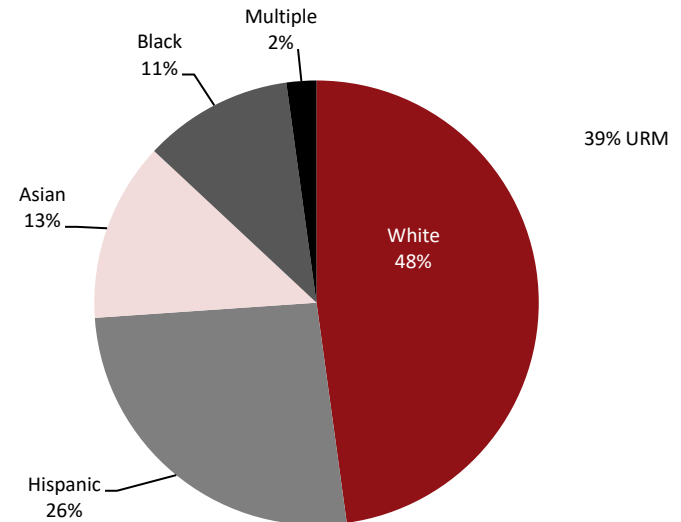
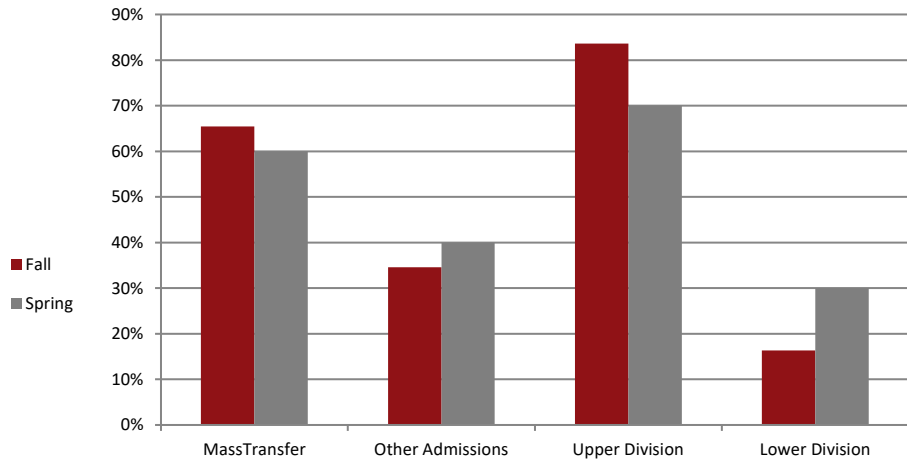


Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity Fall 2019

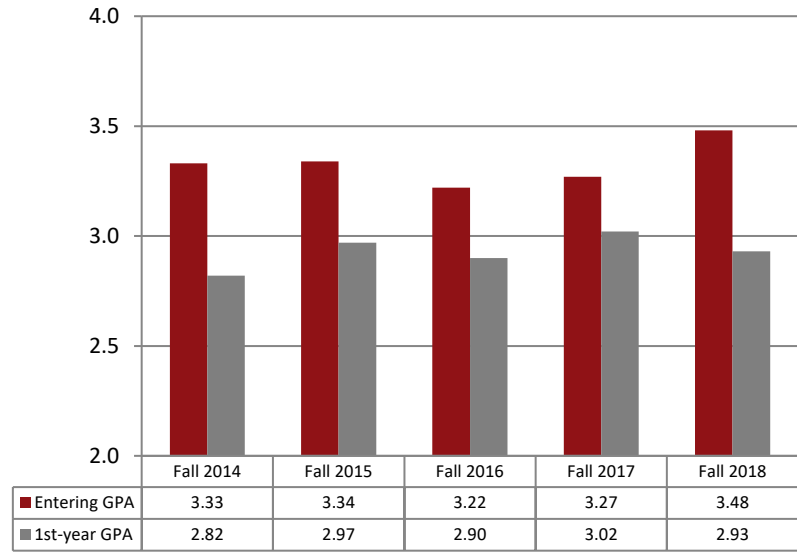
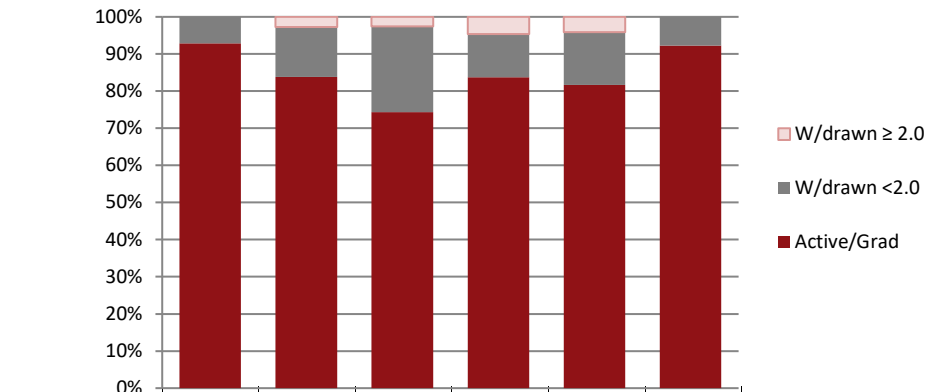
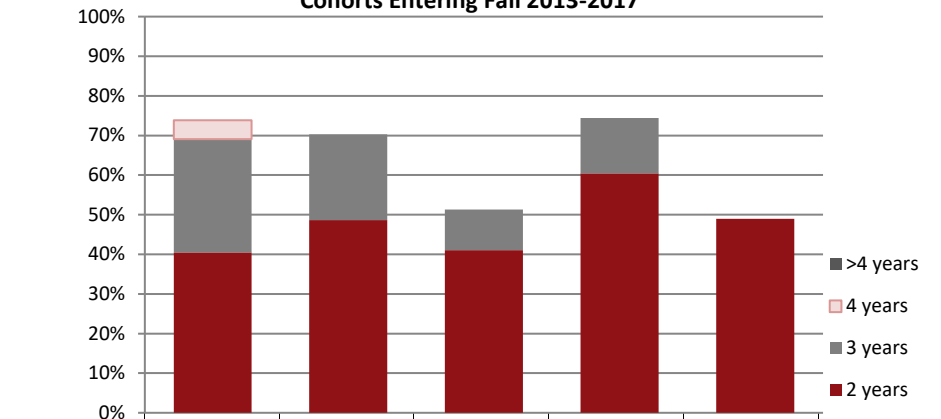


Fig. 7 **One-Year Retention of Full-time MassTransfer Students**

Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20**

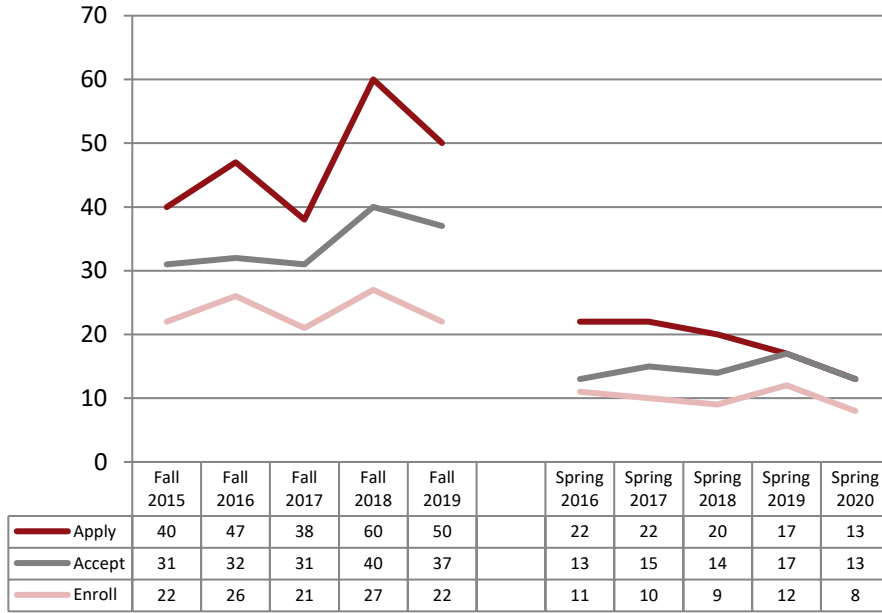

Academic Year 2019-2020**

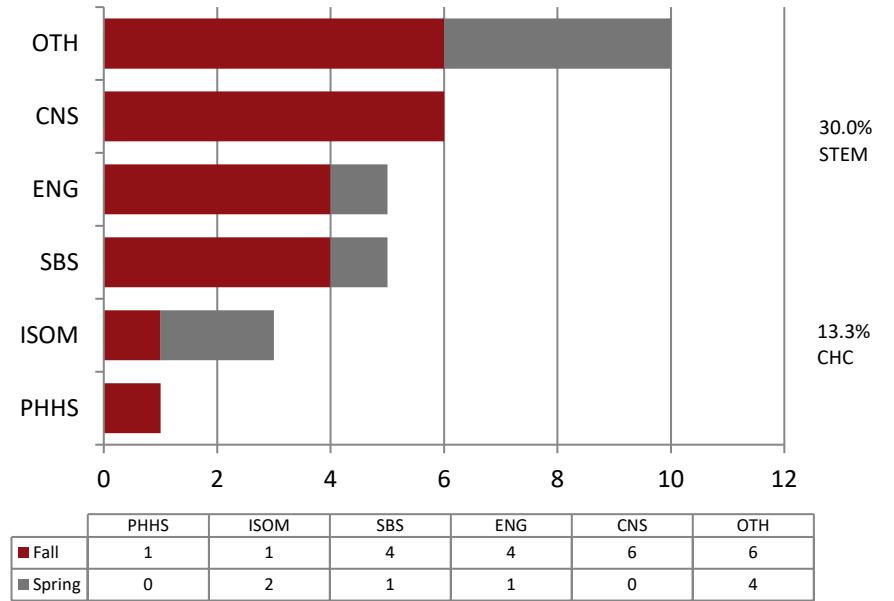

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**

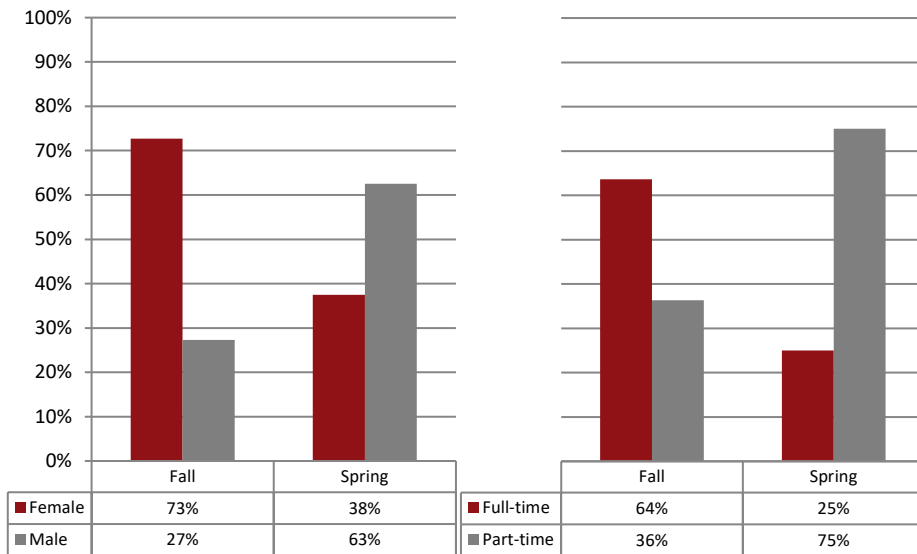
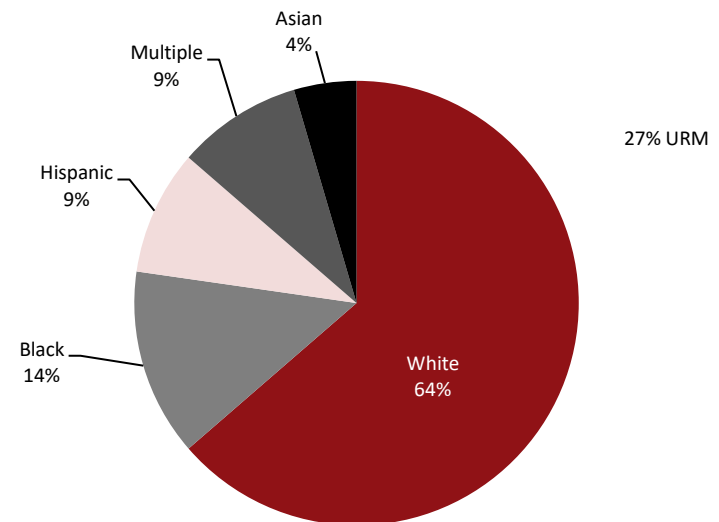

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**

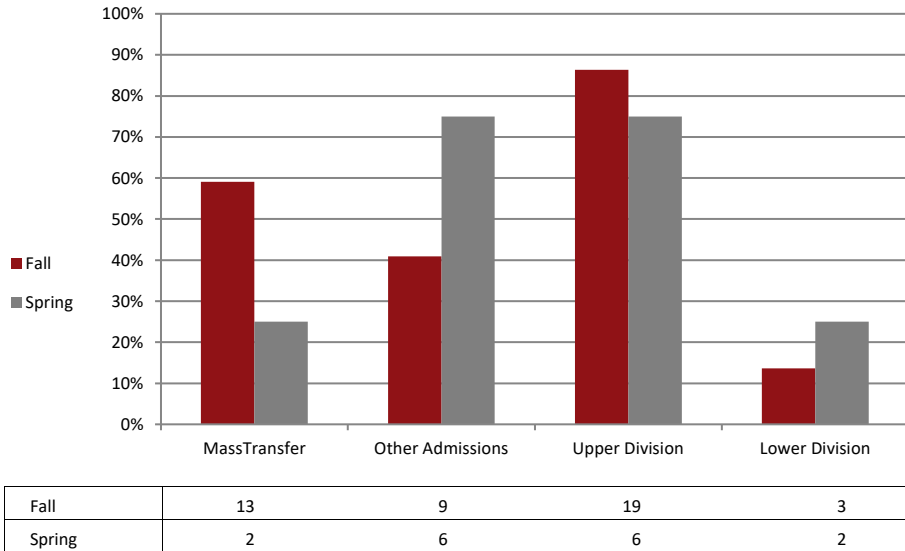


Fig. 6 **Entering and First-Year GPA of Full-time MassTransfer Students  
Entering Fall 2014-2018**

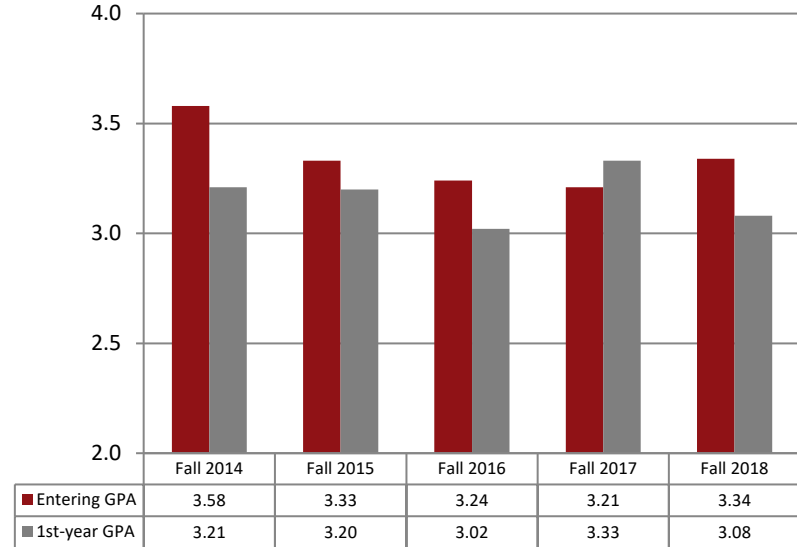


Fig. 7 **One Year Retention of Full-Time MassTransfer Students

Fig. 1 Applications, Acceptances and Enrollments Academic Years 2015-16 - 2019-20

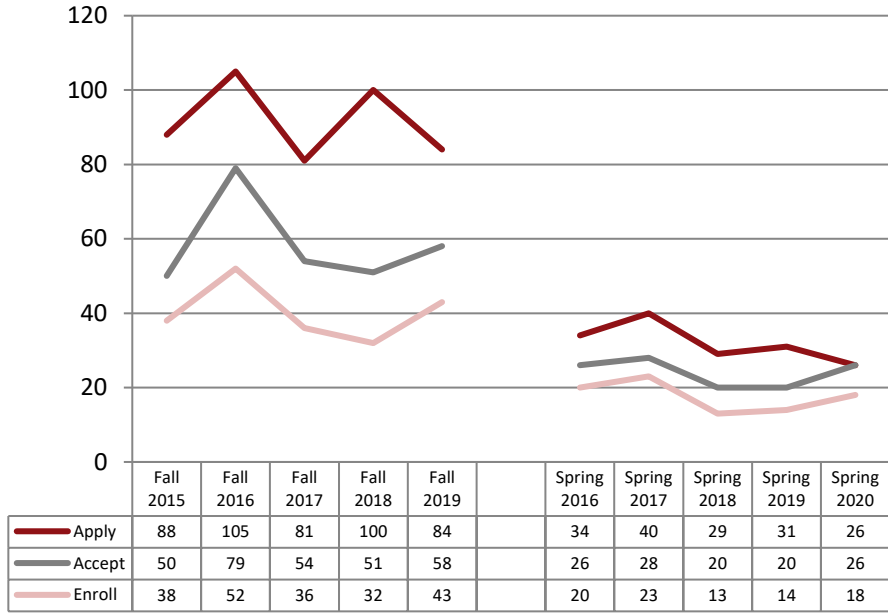


Fig. 2 Entering Students by School/College of Major Academic Year 2019-2020

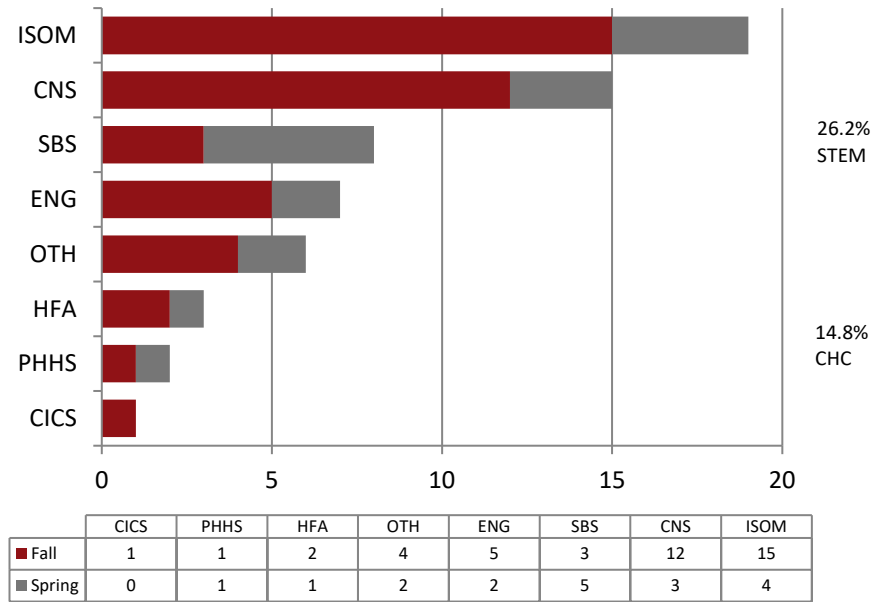


Fig. 3 Enrollment of Entering Transfers by Gender and Full-Time Status Fall 2019 - Spring 2020

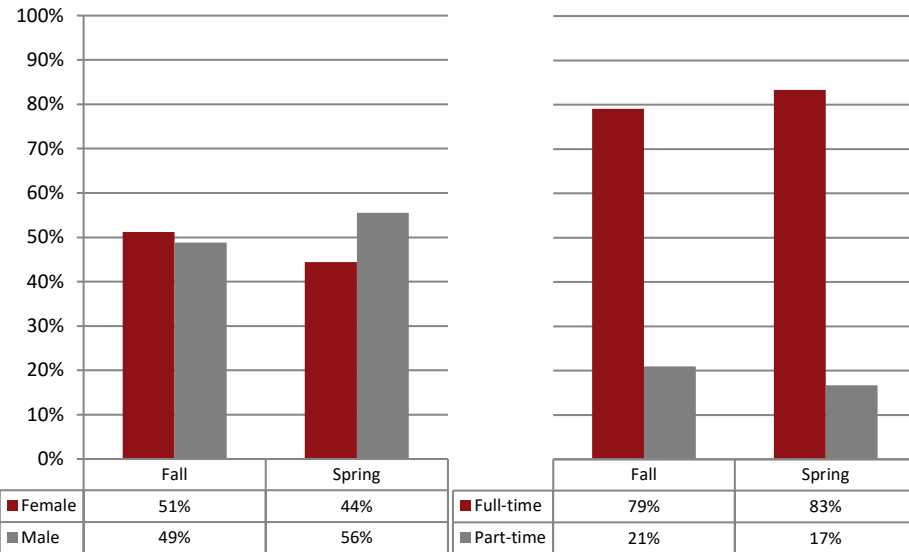
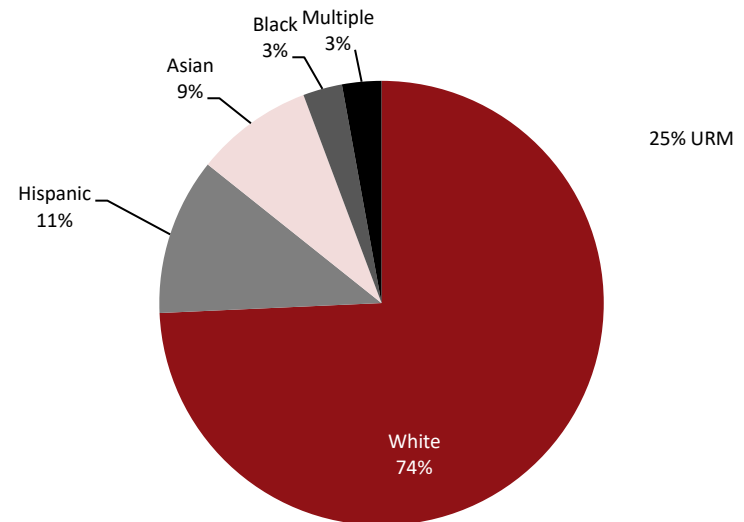


Fig. 4 Distribution of Entering Transfers by Race/Ethnicity Fall 2019

Fall 2019 - Spring 2020**

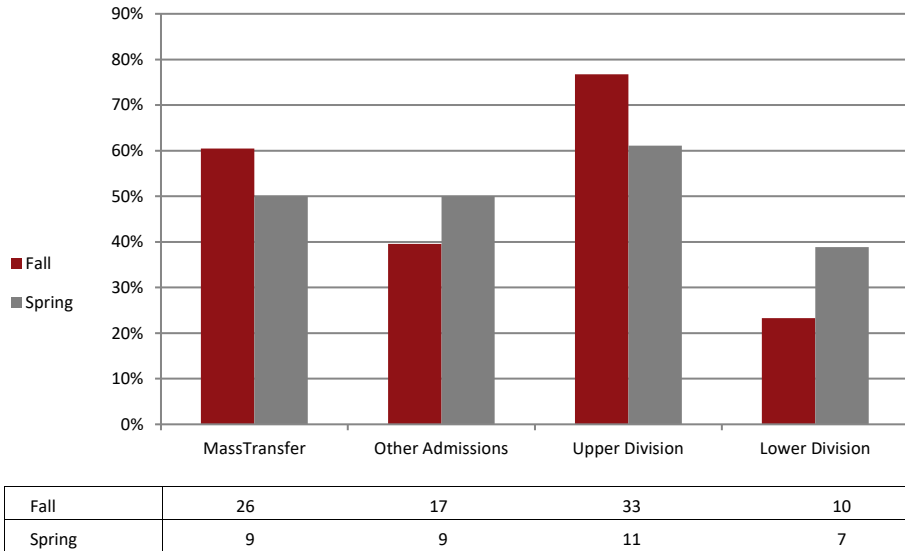


Fig. 6 **Entering and First-Year GPA of Full-time MassTransfer Students  
Entering Fall 2014-2018**

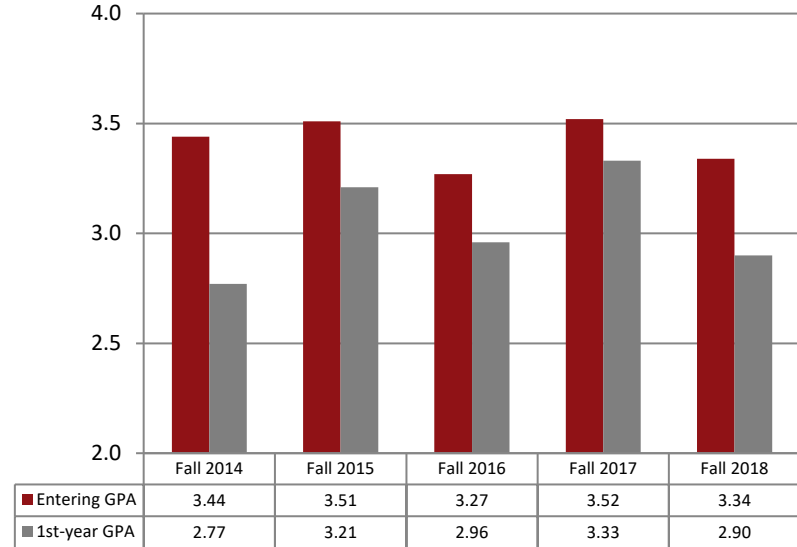


Fig. 7 **One Year Retention of Full-Time MassTransfer Students
