Definitions and Notes

Out-of-state: Out-of-state includes Regional Program Participants. At the undergraduate level, it also includes International students.

Transfer: A student who earned 12 or more credits at another higher education institution prior to enrolling at UMass Amherst.

Note 2: Only state-supported programs and degree-seeking students enrolled in these programs are included (i.e. programs administered by Continuing & Professional Education and non-degree students are excluded).

Note 3: Undergraduate students are counted based on the student's primary major.

Note 4: Master's includes Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (C.A.G.S.) and Education Specialist (Ed.S.) in the College of Education.

Note 5: Undergraduate numbers include enrollments in Associate's degree programs.
