Note 3. Race/Ethnicity is based on students' voluntary self-report.

Note 4. Minority students include American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian, Pacific Islander, Black/African American, Hispanic or Latino of any race and Two or More Races. Non-minority includes White, Non-reporting and Non-resident Alien.

Note 5. In 2010 federal race/ethnicity standards changed, allowing individuals to specify more than one race, as well as splitting, renaming and adding categories.
