Data include both full-time and part-time students.

Time to degree is calculated based on elapsed time in terms of years. For example, students who start in September and complete their degree in May of their second year are displayed as 1.7 years (i.e. 1.7 years = 2 academic years).

Based on currently active master's programs with at least five students graduating between 2014-15 and 2018-19. Programs with less than five students are not shown but are included in the totals.

Includes degrees awarded in September, February and May of the academic year.

Includes only students who enrolled in Summer 1995 or later.

Students who earned degrees in joint programs are counted separately in each program.
