UMASS Amherst reviews and if warranted, investigates animal care problems and/or welfare complaints as required by the Animal Welfare Act regulations [9 CFR, Part 2.31 ©(4)], and the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (IV.B.4). "Whistle Blower Protection": Massachusetts General Law Ch. 149 §185 states that an employers may not retaliate against employees who report violation of law or risks to public health, safety or the environment. Retaliation includes discharge, suspension, demotion, or other adverse action taken in terms or conditions of employment.
