Event Attendee Information

VACCINATION/COVID TEST

The University expects indoor event attendees to be vaccinated or have a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the event. Please bring proof of vaccination or negative test result in the event verification is requested. For University of Massachusetts Amherst students, faculty and staff, a valid UCard is sufficient.

FACE COVERINGS REQUIREMENTS

All attendees are required to wear face coverings when indoors except when eating. While outdoors, face coverings should be worn when social distancing is not possible.

STAY HOME IF YOU

- 1. Are sick or have COVID-19 symptoms:
 - Temperature over 100.3F
 - New Loss of smell or taste
 - Muscle aches
 - Sore throat
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Chills
 - Headache
 - Fatigue
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Gastrointestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of appetite
 - Been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or been placed in quarantine for possible contact with COVID-19
- 2. Have been in close contact with an individual diagnosed or exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms within the past 14 days unless you have been fully vaccinated (2 weeks past your final shot).
- 3. Have been directed to self-isolate or quarantine by health care provider or public health official.
- 4. Are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test.

WASH HANDS

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after using the restroom, before eating and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. Hand sanitizer will be widely available throughout the facility.
