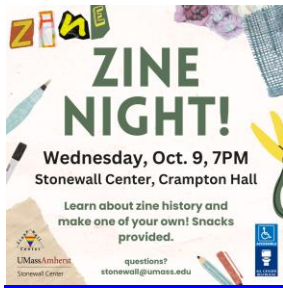


### *Bi/Pan/Queer Collective (BPQC) Weekly Meeting*

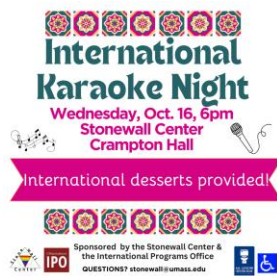

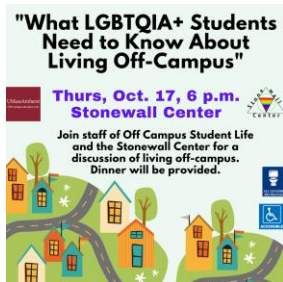

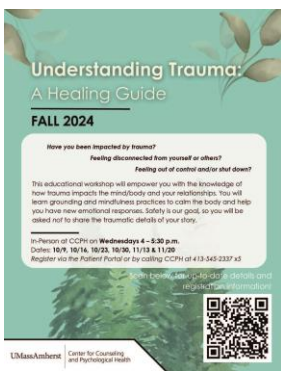
