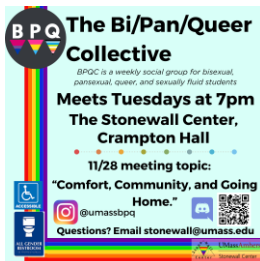

No appointment needed. STI tests screen for gonorrhea and chlamydia. Don't urinate for 1-2 hours before the test. HIV testing involves a finger prick. Results are ready in 20-30 minutes. "Cultural Appropriation vs. Appreciation"

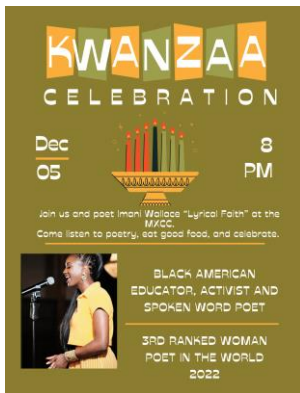
Thurs., Nov. 30, 4-5 p.m., Malcolm X Cultural Center
