# Context

## (or: *Why is strategic planning important?*)

- More and more of our **operating budget** is coming from student tuition
- Student – and societal – **expectations** for higher education are rising
- Student **interests** are shifting
- **Competition** for high quality students is increasing
- **Employers** are focusing on preparation and job-readiness

# University Strategic Plan 2018-2023

## Strategic Goals

1. Destination of Choice
2. Partner of Choice
3. Community of Choice

## Overarching Principles

1. Mobilize all resources to achieve a sustainable financial strategy
2. Instill a culture of evidence at all levels that applies the best possible information and analysis to decisions

## Undergraduate Education

***“A world-class educational experience is defined in terms of students success:***

***providing students with the educational and personal development opportunities they seek***

***and the preparation they will need***

***in a timely, effective, and coherent way.”***

# Educational Effectiveness Plan (EEP)

- What: Systematically assess the effectiveness of the department's efforts to support student success, on an ongoing basis
- Why: Generate timely information for the department to use in Unit Planning, Annual Budget Planning, AQAD reports, Accreditation, etc. on an ongoing basis

# Educational Effectiveness Planning for SACL

## Spring 2019

1. Identify your cluster's **experiential goals and learning objectives** for students
2. Review how those goals/objectives **align** with your cluster's services, programs, practices
3. Identify & analyze the **evidence** you currently have about students' progress on those goals/objectives
4. Identify the **actions** your cluster will take (or has taken) to improve or enhance students' progress on those goals/objectives
5. Identify your cluster's **questions** about the quality of students' experiences, learning and development, and develop a cluster-defined **line of inquiry** to answer those questions



# Cluster Workshop
