• <u>Why</u>: Generate timely information for the department to use in Unit Planning, Annual Budget Planning, AQAD reports, Accreditation, etc. on an ongoing basis

# **Educational Effectiveness Planning for SACL**

#### Spring 2019

- Identify your cluster's experiential goals and learning objectives for students
- 2. Review how those goals/objectives **align** with your cluster's services, programs, practices
- 3. Identify & analyze the **evidence** you currently have about students' progress on those goals/objectives
- 4. Identify the **actions** your cluster will take (or has taken) to improve or enhance students' progress on those goals/objectives
- Identify your cluster's questions about the quality of students' experiences, learning and development, and develop a cluster-defined line of inquiry to answer those questions
