M.S. in Sustainability Science

Sustainability Science is a one-year professional master's degree program that trains students for sustainability-focused careers in industry, academia, government, and the nonprofit sector. The program is grounded in the philosophy that solving societal challenges requires a new generation of diverse and creative leaders who have an understanding of integrated sustainability thinking, rigorous interdisciplinary academic training and practical hands-on experience. As such, it is tailored to meet these challenges and prepare our students to be highly competitive on the green job market. The program can be completed in 12 months if attending full-time.

Who is this program designed for?

Sustainability is a broad field that attracts students from a variety of backgrounds, including the life sciences, social sciences, engineering, humanities, arts and policy. The program is enriched by the diversity in perspectives and life experiences our students bring with them.
