About the Dashboard

This dashboard provides course registrations (counting students enrolled in each course they are taking) and credit hours (counting students enrolled in a course multiplied by the credit hour value of the course) categorized by the course offering entity. This information is provided for:

- University, UWW, and Mount Ida course sessions
- Undergraduate and graduate courses

By default, the dashboard shows all course registrations.

How you can use the Data

You can use the data on this dashboard to answer questions such as:

- Have course registrations increased in courses offered by computer science?
- Is an increase in course registration driven by students from within the college or from other colleges/schools?
- Have UWW student credit hours increased in Nursing over the last five years?

About the Data

A “snapshot” is taken of university data each semester, on the weekend after the add/drop period ends. The data captured in this snapshot are referred to as **Official** on this dashboard and match data published by Institutional Research. This contrasts with **Live** data which gives a current look at the University’s data (refreshed nightly). For past semesters, these data can differ from the official data because of changes that occur during the semester (e.g. major declaration) or after the semester (back dated information). For current and future semesters, live data show what is in progress and may look very different from past terms (e.g. enrollment for a future term will look low if not everyone has registered).

Data Descriptions

Course Registrations: Students are counted in each course in which they have enrolled.

Credit Hours: The number of students in a course multiplied by the number of credit hours associated with the course.

Course Session: The entity that offers the course.

Course UG/Grad: Distinguishes undergraduate from graduate courses.

Course Component: Type of course section, includes lectures, seminars, laboratory sessions, etc.

Class Instruction Mode: The modality used to deliver the course (e.g., In Person, Online).

School/College (in the Comparison Metric): The school/college of the students taking the courses of interest.

Department (in the Comparison Metric): The department of the students taking the courses of interest.

Major (in the Comparison Metric): The major of the students taking the courses of interest.

School/College (in the table): The school/college offering the courses of interest. *Please note – clicking on Null under School/College will show non-Veterinary Technology courses at the Mount Ida Campus.*

Class Department (in the table): The department offering the courses of interest.

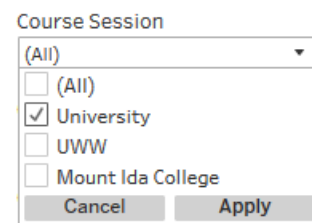
Class Subject (in the table): The course rubric of the courses of interest.

Dashboard Tips

- Navigation buttons on the upper left of the dashboard will let you **Undo** your last action or **Reset** back to the original dashboard view.
- When exploring data, keep in mind which filters you have set. Sometimes it helps to **Reset** to the original dashboard view and start again.



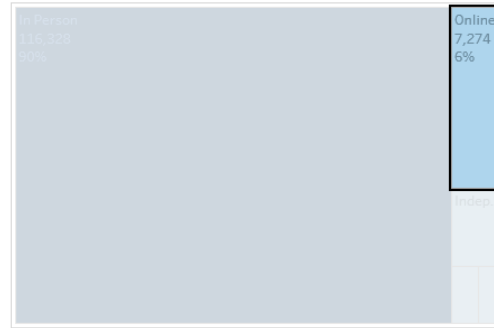
- To use a filter, click on the boxes next to the features you want to see and then click **Apply**.



- You can also filter the data by clicking on a row of information such as one of the Schools or Colleges.

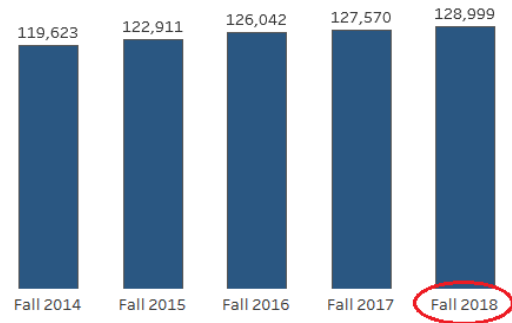

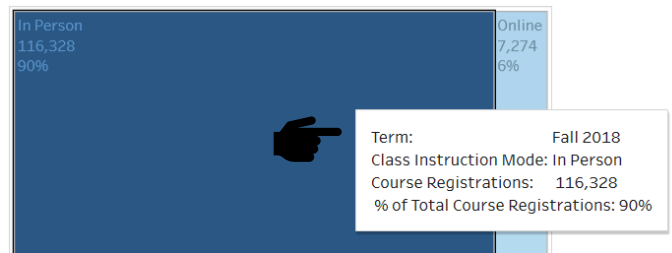
- When you select a **Start Term**, this will be the latest term shown in the Five-Year Trend chart.

Course Registrations 5 Year Trend

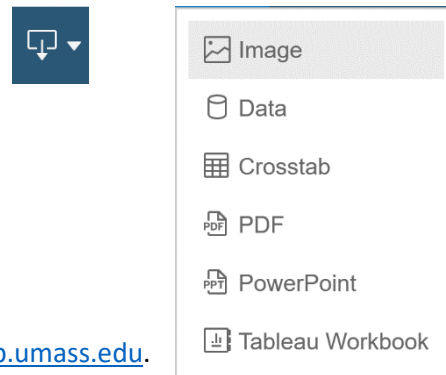


- To learn more details about information in a chart, hover your cursor and a **Tooltip** will appear.
