Note A: Graduation status is reported as of the end of the sixth year after initial enrollment. Some students graduate after that point but are not included in this summary.

Note B: In 2010 federal race/ethnicity standards changed, allowing individuals to specify more than one race, as well as splitting, renaming and adding categories.

Because of these changes, data from fall 2010 forward are not comparable to previous years.

Note C: Race/Ethnicity is based upon students' voluntary self-report at time of admission; it does not reflect new federal reporting standards prior to the Fall 2010 cohort.

Note D: Students who enlist in the military or who are deceased are removed from the cohort.

Note E: URM (Underrepresented Minority): includes American Indian/Alaska Native, Black/African American, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic Latino, and those who declared
