

## Fall 2022 Registration Advisory for UWW Interdisciplinary Studies Students

Registration for fall courses begins **Monday, June 6**. However, that may not be the date that you can begin enrolling. Enrollment appointments for the fall and spring semesters are automatically generated for each student, giving you a specific date and time when you can begin registering. You can find your enrollment appointment date and time in a box called "Enrollment Dates" on the right side of your SPIRE homepage. Enrollment appointments are assigned approximately one week before registration begins (or within one business day of matriculation if you sent your Intent to Enroll on or after this date). If you do not receive an enrollment appointment within this timeframe, contact [UWW Records and Registration](#).

### How to Register for Classes in SPIRE

1. Log in to [SPIRE](#).
2. Check to make sure your enrollment appointment has started in the "Enrollment Dates" box on the right side of your SPIRE homepage.
3. Click the yellow box on the right side of your SPIRE homepage that says "Search for Classes."
4. Select the correct "Term" (Fall 2022).
5. Under "Course Subject," select the appropriate option. To register for UWW Interdisciplinary Studies courses, choose "University Without Walls."
6. Under "Session," choose "UWW." If you would like to search for a class with non-standard dates, choose "UWW Non-standard Dates."

7. Click "Search." You will see a list of classes. A green circle next to "Status" indicates that the class is open.
8. Click on the class number next to where it says "Section" to read a course description, and then click "View Search Results" to return to the previous page.
9. If a class has "Days & Times" listed, make sure they fit your schedule. If it only says "TBA," it is asynchronous, meaning you do not have to log in at any specific time.
10. To choose a class, click "Select Class."
11. Click "Next." Doing this will add the class to your shopping cart.
12. Now click on your shopping cart. Select the classes you want and click "Enroll."
13. You can confirm your enrollment by visiting your schedule, which is located on your SPIRE homepage at the top of the page under the heading "Academics."
